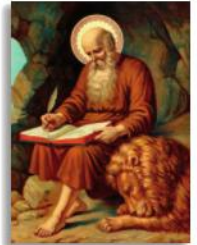

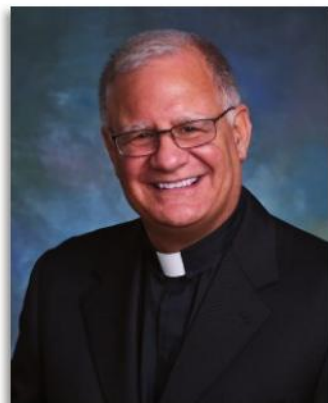
Dear Friends:

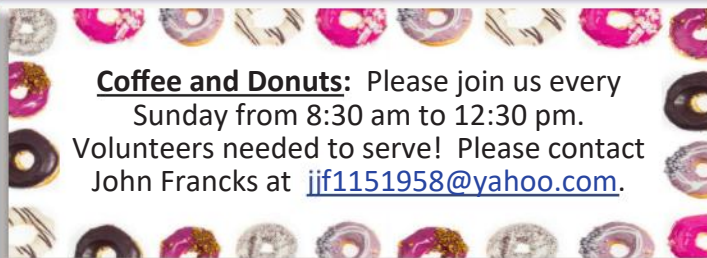
