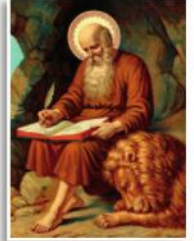



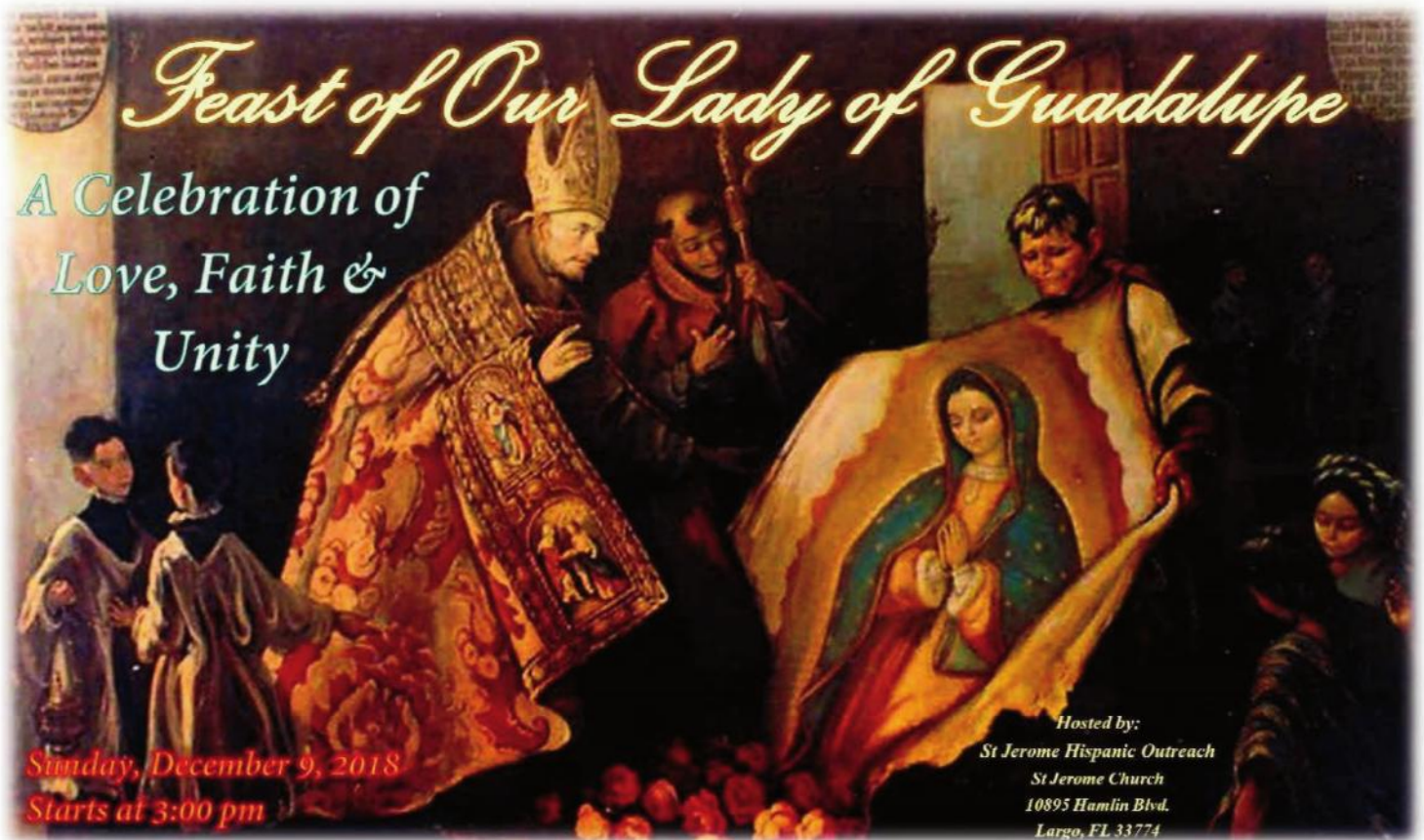

Children's Liturgy of the Word will again be available for all children who have not yet received their First Communion the 9am Mass. It will be held the first and last Sunday of every month now through May.

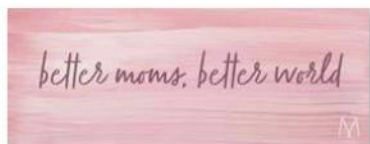

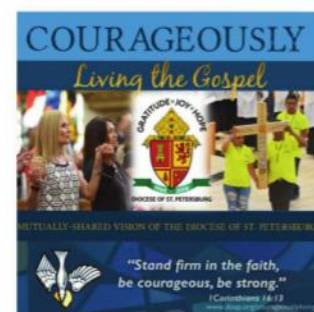
## THE DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX SURVEY!

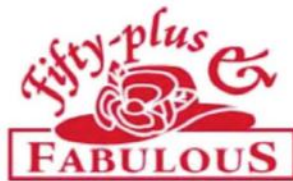

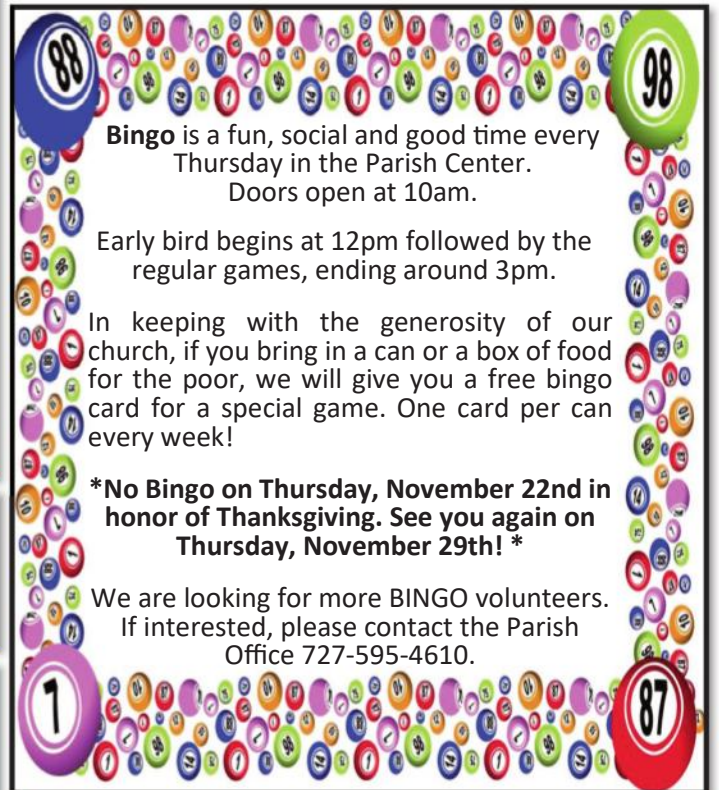
