

We are happy to have available an Epiphany home blessing kit for you today. Since the Middle Ages, there has been a tradition that on (or near) the feast of the Epiphany, we pray for God's blessing on our homes, marking the door post with chalk (an incarnational image reminding us of the dust of the earth from which we were made). We mark the main door of our home with the initials of the Magi and the numerals of the New Year, connected with crosses: "20 + C + M + B + 19". The initials remind us of the legendary names of the Magi – Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, and also stand for the Latin motto:

Christus mansionem benedicat "May Christ bless this house."

In the book of Exodus, the Israelites marked their doors with the blood so that the Lord would pass over their homes; but in this ritual, we mark our doors with chalk as a sign that we have invited God's presence and blessing into our homes. Included in the Epiphany home blessing kit is a piece of chalk and the prayers for the blessing.

The Epiphany of the Lord

"They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh..." - Matthew 2:11

Notice the distinct order of events in the Magi's visit. First they knelt before Jesus and prayed to Him. Then they presented Him with their gifts. We too must take time to pray before we presume to present our gifts to the Lord. We never know what gifts God might be asking us to share. But when we kneel before Him in prayer we will find the answer.
