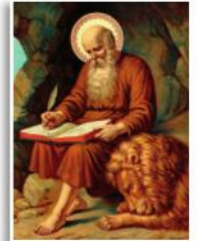

St Jerome Catholic Church – Financial Update

The Financial Council of St. Jerome Church has reviewed the Financial Statements for the second quarter (Q2) representing the six (6) months ended December 31, 2018. The chart shows a breakdown of the revenues and expenses for the 6 month period. **As a result, total expenses of \$987,486 exceeded total revenues of \$919,215 by \$68,251.** Total expenses include; pastor expenses, worship & music, faith formation, administration and facilities, and property, plant and equipment. Although our expenses are down \$48,500 from the prior year, administration expenses and facilities, property, plant and equipment have exceeded budgeted amounts by \$53,000 and \$36,000 respectively.

Our APA assessment for the year is \$292,644. Although we have collected \$126,071, we have begun making payments for the anticipated shortfall to the Diocese. St. Jerome must make this shortfall up from its offertory revenues. At December 31, 2018, we have paid \$167,571 towards our assessment, **leaving us a balance of \$125,073.** The Council felt it was prudent to start making monthly payments now.

We continue to pay down our outstanding debt at \$8,950 per month to include principal and interest at a fixed rate 3.96%. The loan for the church renovation of \$2.5 million dollars incurred in September 2011, is now at \$1,265,148 and balloons in September 2019.

The Finance Council thanks Fr. Tom Morgan for his leadership here at St. Jerome and we continue to pray for fiscal responsibility and guidance as we move forward into the second half of the year with the shortfalls noted above.

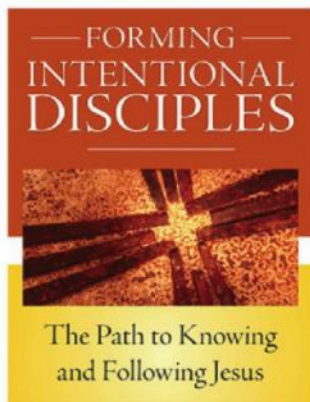

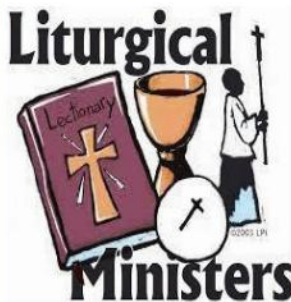

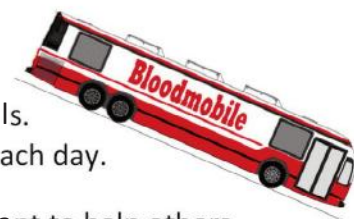
