

## **Our Lady of the Angels Image**

Located in the city of Cartago in Costa Rica is the Basilica that is dedicated to the Lady of the Angels. Local legend says this all came about when a small statue of the Virgin Mary holding baby Jesus was found by a young girl in the city. The girl took the statue from the rock where she had found it and brought it home, but when she awoke the next morning the statue was gone. She discovered that the statue was back on the rock

where she had found it. The girl then took the statue to a local priest where he locked it up for the night. The next morning the statue was no longer locked up, but back on the rock. This happened five more times as others took the image home, and each time it was found in the place where the girl found it in the first place. Finally, the locals took this as a sign that the Virgin wanted a permanent shrine built on that site.

An image of Our Lady of Angels, Patroness of Costa Rica, will be brought here to St Jerome on Saturday September 21st and will remain in the Chapel for the following week. All are invited to come and pray.
