This represents the financial information for the Parish for the first quarter of the fiscal year ended June 30, 2020. While total revenues are down \$13,923 or 3% from the prior year, total expenses are also down \$28,324 or 5.5% representing a decrease in our bottom line of \$14,418. We have collected \$114,160 towards our APA Assessment of \$267,573 and have a balance due to the Diocese of \$157,413 that if not raised through APA will need to be paid with parish savings.



#### WELCOMING THE PRINCE OF PEACE

**Advent** is a time of joyous preparation for the coming of the Prince of Peace. It is a special time because it celebrates His coming into our world *today*, here and now. Jesus is "born" becomes physically tangible through the celebration of the sacraments. It is by eating the Eucharist, washing in the waters of Baptism, and so on, that Jesus' friends become part of the living Body of Christ (the Church) in the world today.



#### PREPARING TO FULLY CELEBRATE ADVENT

<u>Celebrations</u> - Attend special celebrations held at the church during the Advent season, make an effort to add in an additional Mass to attend (the Feast of St. Nick Dec 6; Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe Dec 12)






