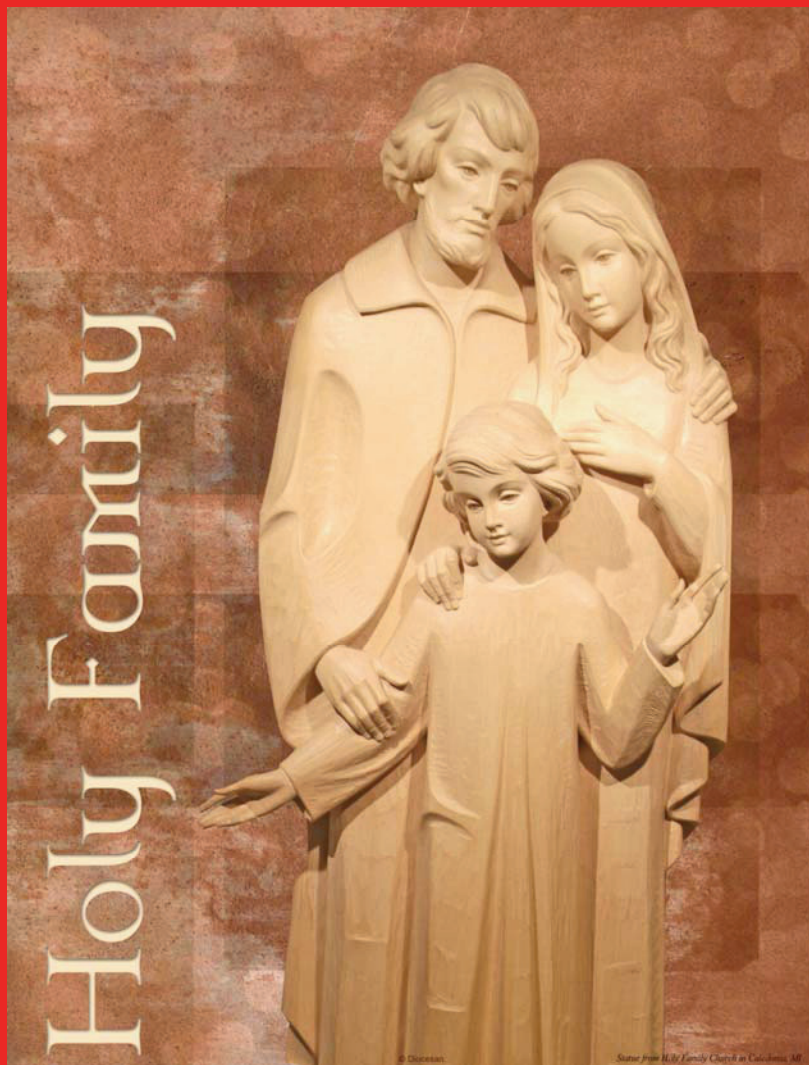
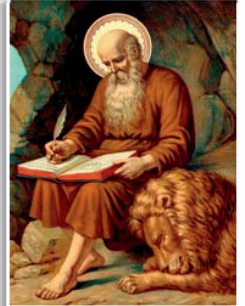

Dear Friends:

We believe when Jesus spoke to John from the Cross and told him, "Behold your mother" (John 19:27), He was giving Mary His Mother to all believers. On Friday, January 1st, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, a Holy Day of Obligation.

Masses are: Thursday, December 31st - 4:00pm Vigil
 Friday, January 1st - 7:00am, 9:00am, and 11:00am.

Drive-through distribution of Holy Communion will follow the 4:00pm Vigil Mass on Thursday and the 11:00am Mass on Friday.

The Church teaches that, "In fact, the One whom she conceived as man by the Holy Spirit, who truly became her Son according to the flesh, was none other than the Father's eternal Son, the second person of the Holy Trinity. Hence the Church confesses that Mary is truly "Mother of God" (Theotokos)." #495 The Catechism of the Catholic Church. Mary is indeed the Mother of Jesus, the Mother of God. She is also the Mother of all Christians. As we begin this new year, let us draw close to Mary who always leads those she loves closer to her Son Jesus. Let us consider and reflect on the few words she speaks in the Holy Scriptures and let us consider and reflect on some of the words spoken about her:

Luke 1:38 - "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord."

Luke 1:46 & 47 - "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my savior."

Luke 2:19 - "And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

John 2:5 - "Do whatever, He tells you."

John 19:25 - "Standing by the cross of Jesus were his mother ... "

A MESSAGE ON THE WEARING OF MASKS AT MASS

It has been our policy to ask all those attending Mass at St Jerome to wear masks. It will continue to be so until the CDC tells us that this no longer necessary. We will continue to have masks available for those who forget to bring a mask or their mask breaks during Mass. We ask for your cooperation, for there is a real concern on the part of some of our parishioners that their health could be compromised by those not wearing masks.

It is clearly sacrificial to wear a mask. We are aware, however, that some are unable to wear masks due to their health condition. I would remind everyone that Bishop Gregory Parkes' dispensation not to attend Mass, due to an individual being unable to attend a public gathering because of the possibility of their health being compromised, remains in effect. In addition, we will continue to have Holy Communion available by drive through for those who participate by watching Mass on Livestream and then driving to church for reception of the Eucharist. It will not be the policy to *enforce* the wearing of masks. As good disciples, however, we seek to walk in knowledge and freedom, always keeping the good of others in mind. Since we seek to practice Jesus' mandate in Mt. 18:15, we ask those not wearing masks to please understand if a fellow worshiper asks the reason you are not wearing a mask. I request that those not wearing masks to please understand if others choose not sit by them in church. We ask for your assistance during this time by wearing a mask if you choose to attend Mass.

CHURCH LIGHTING REPAIRS



As many of you have experienced, we are having lighting problems with the system that controls our church lights. This system is very sophisticated and it has taken several experts assisting us to determine the exact cause. We now feel we have located the source of the problem, and we have shipped back to the manufacturer the dimming system panels for them to analyze and repair. We learned that one of the panels had three modules that would need to be replaced.

The company is now repairing the panel that is not working. We expect to receive both panels back in early January. They will be reinstalled and all the bulbs will be completely replaced to get the lighting system back to the baseline we had when they were newly installed. This process many take several weeks. We appreciate your patience as we get our lighting system "back to new."
