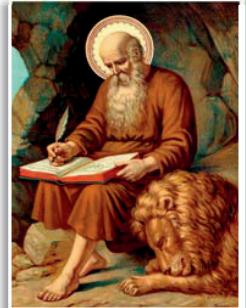

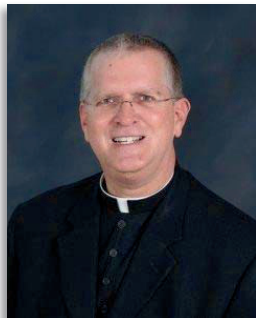

LENT 2021: Tree of Charity (Love)

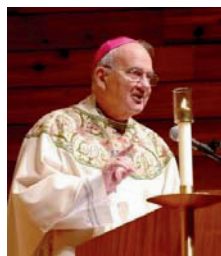

We welcome Fr. George Mangiaracina, a visiting priest in the Diocese, who will be assisting us from time to time. Fr. George presents his bio below.

I was born in Canarsie, Brooklyn, New York. I was baptized in the church of the Holy Family a month later, and I would go to school there in 1957. In 1959, my father was transferred temporarily to Rome, Italy. In the 15 months my family was there, I went to the American Overseas School (1959-1960) and Mary Mount (1960-1961). In January of 1961, my father was transferred back to New York, and this time we lived in Staten Island, NY and I went to Our Lady Star of the Sea School (1961), graduating from that school in 1967.

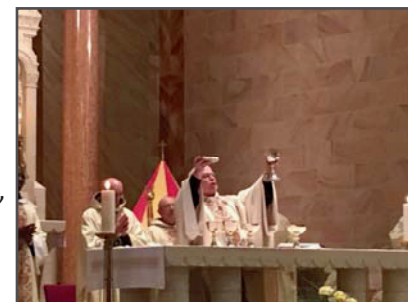
In 1967 my family moved to Randallstown, Maryland in Baltimore County. After going to three schools there, my father was transferred back to New York. This time we settled in Flanders, New Jersey, and I graduated from high school there at West Morris Regional High School. During my last years in high school I felt drawn to consider a vocation to the priesthood. To discern my vocation I entered the MSC College Formation Program in Center Valley, Pennsylvania in 1971, and I remained with them until 1981. During my time with them I earned an AA Degree from Lehigh County Community College, a BA with a major in history, and minor in Philosophy from St. Francis de Sales College, and a Master of Divinity Degree from Catholic Theological Union (1980). My departure from them was motivated in part by a discovery that I might have a contemplative vocation; but I just did not know where the Lord wanted me to go with it.

So in 1981 I went to Simmons College of Library and Information Science to develop a marketable skill, and in 1983 I received my degree there. From there I went to Contoocook, NH to work for Yankee Book Peddler. After about a year there I returned to Boston to work at the Congregational Library. After I settled down as a layman, I began to take up the matter of my vocation, and after looking at several monasteries, I felt drawn to the Discalced Carmelite Friars, joining them in 1986. After I completed my novitiate in 1988, I took my first vows, and in 1992 I took my solemn vows and I was ordained to the diaconate. I went to my province's parish at St. Florian's in West Milwaukee and while there I preached, presided at baptisms, gravesite services, and ran three RCIA programs at the same time.

In 1993, I was ordained to the priesthood, and I was asked to be a spiritual director to our secular order communities: first out of West Milwaukee, then out of Washington, DC, and finally out of our retreat house in Peterborough, NH. Then in 1996, I went to Discalced Carmelite Friars' Pontifical School, the Teresianum, in Rome, but in 1997 I shifted to the Benedictine School of Saint Anselmo to study the liturgy. From there I receive my licentiate in 2001, and my doctorate in 2008.

After I received my doctorate, I went to work for Boston College in October, to assist while a Jesuit still needed time to recover from being hit by a car the year before. The following year I taught for a time at Washington Theological Union, and then in 2011, I began teaching at the Priests of the Sacred Heart seminary in Hales Corner where I taught until 2020.

My father passed away in 2015, and over the years my mother needed more of my attention. So I came to Largo, Florida to be with her and to be available for the parishes here in the Diocese of St. Petersburg.
