

Then you shall know that I am the LORD, when I open your graves and have you rise from them ... I have promised, and I will do it, says the LORD."



- M: Find life where there is only death. Revisit a ruined relationship, an unhealed memory, and ask God to grow new life in the barren place.


#### In Gratitude to God For His Gifts to Us


