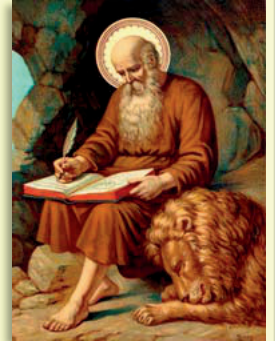

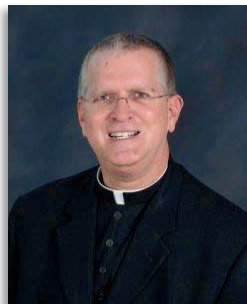

- Attending Confirmation classes every Sunday at 3:30 pm, reflecting on Dynamic Catholic Decision Point study material. Be Bold. Be Catholic.
- Attending the day long Fire & Ice Confirmation retreat at Mary Help of Christians in Tampa.
- The Confirmation candidates shared about their journey and their Confirmation saint they chose at the 5:00 pm Sunday Life Teen Mass.
- The candidates formally requested receiving the Sacrament by writing a letter to me and they completed an interview with Fr. Rob on moving forward after Confirmation and what it means to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Part 4 - The Veneration of the Altar



The altar “is by its very nature a table of sacrifice and at the same time a table of the paschal banquet” (Dedication of a Church and an Altar, Chapter IV, no. 4). It is a symbol of Christ as well as of the whole Christian community since “Christians who give themselves to prayer, who offer petitions to God and present sacrifices of

supplication, are the living stones from which the Lord Jesus builds the Church’s altar” (Ibid., no. 2). The veneration of the altar at the beginning of the celebration is an act of greeting which recalls that the common table is holy and sacred to the action of the assembly. It is the place from which prayer ascends like incense before God (cf. Psalm 141.2).

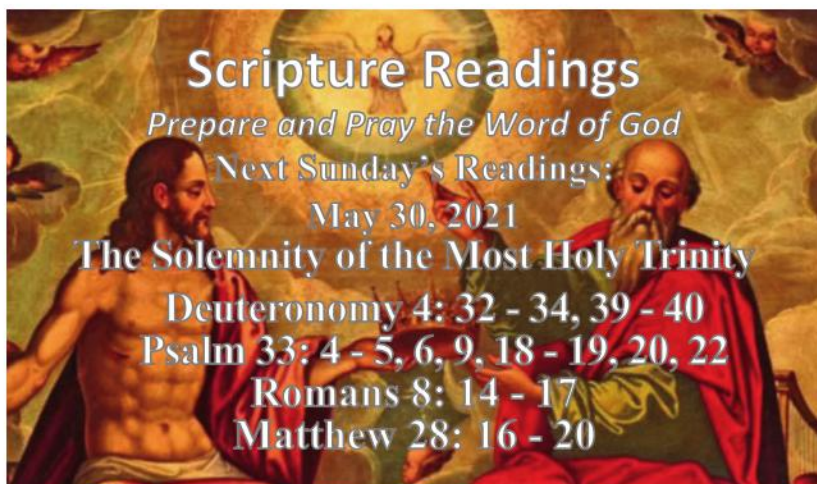
