

The months of June, July, and August:

- As announced by the CDC on May 13, those fully-vaccinated do not need to wear a mask. Those who wish to wear a mask are invite to do so

- Large print missalettes and Breaking Bread Missal and Hymnal available for use at Mass
- Livestreaming of Masses and other liturgical events continues
- Drive-through Confession at the north entrance of the church
- Drive-through distribution of Holy Communion on Saturday at 5:00 pm and Sunday at 12 noon at the north entrance of the church
- Novena to Our Lady of Perpetual Help led by a priest on Saturday mornings at 8:45 am
- Holy Water available in the Baptismal Font and Holy Water fonts at the entrances of the church and chapel
- Procession for the Eucharistic gifts at Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses
- Daily Mass celebrated in the church
- Mass in the Church and the Parish Center for the 4:00 pm Saturday Vigil. Sunday Masses in the Church at 7:00 am, 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 5:00 pm
- Ministries or individual groups meeting under agreed-upon guidelines for COVID-19 safety: Baptism Classes, RCIA, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Confirmation and Youth Ministry, AA and AL anon, Grief Share, Life-Line Food Bank, Homeless Meal Ministry, Legion of Mary, 11:00 am Sunday Choir, Spirit Singers Children Choir, and our Life Teen 5:00 pm Sunday Mass Choir

It is our hope that as of September 1, 2021:

- The 4:00 pm Saturday Vigil Mass in the Parish Center ends
- Our previous Sunday Mass schedule returns for September, 2021- May, 2022: Saturday Vigil: 4:00 pm and 5:30 pm Sunday: 7:30 am, 9:00 am (Family Liturgy), 10:45 am, 12:30 pm, and 5:00 pm Life Teen Mass
- St. Jerome Van Ministry (ride to church) begins on the weekend of September 4, 2021
- The sign of peace resumes during Mass
- We will return to having those at Mass come forward for the reception of Holy Communion
- We will resume the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds when we have been authorized to do so by the Diocese

- Weekly Friday visits by a priest to our homebound parishioners resume
- Priest visitation of the nursing homes located within the boundaries of our parish resumes
- Daily Mass returns to the chapel
- Parish Center Rededication on Sunday, September 12, 2021 following the 11:00 am Sunday Mass, at approximately at 12:15 pm




Peter's Pence Special Collection


