

Dear Friends:

We will continue our tradition of the investiture of the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel at our 9:00 am Sunday Mass on July 18, 2021. We invite all who would like to be invested with the scapular to attend this Mass.

"The Brown Scapular is a Roman Catholic devotion to Mary under the title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. It is worn as a sign of love and devotion for the Mother of God. The Carmelite Order,

to which the Scapular belongs, originated on Mt. Carmel in the Holy Land and the Scapular is itself a reflection in miniature of the habit (scapular: a sleeveless outer garment falling from the shoulders) which monks wear as a sign of their vocation and devotion. Over the years the scapular, at lest for lay people, became much reduced in size, to small pieces of wool cloth suspended front and back.

On July 16, 1251, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon stock in the town of Aylesford, England. St. Simon was a Carmelite who had been a hermit during the time of the Crusades. He was known for his holiness and miracles attested to this after his death. Eventually, he became Prior General and under his guidance the order spread throughout southern and western Europe, particularly in England. It was St. Simon who founded Carmelite houses at Cambridge, Oxford, Paris, and Bologna – part of the reason why the order grew so widely and quickly. He was very


devoted to Mary, and always asked her to bestow a singular privilege on the Carmelites. When Our Lady appeared to him, she granted his desire. She handed him a brown woolen scapular saying, "This shall be a privilege for you and all Carmelites, that anyone dying in this habit shall not suffer eternal fire."

From that time, devotion to the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites increased and before long laypersons wished to participate also. The laity, rather than donning a full habit, embraced a smaller version of it. This scapular symbolizes an allegiance to the Order of Carmel.


UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Part 11 - Liturgy of the Word - General Overview



"In the readings, explained by the homily, God speaks to his people of redemption and salvation and nourishes their spirit; Christ is present among the faithful through his word" (GI no. 33). It is Christ himself "who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read in the Church" (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, art. 7). Just as Christ is present in the eucharist to give himself as food, so he is present when the scriptures are proclaimed to offer his message of redemption and to arouse faith in those who hear his message. "Faith, then, comes through

hearing, and what is heard is the word of Christ" (Romans 10:17). The liturgy of the word, then is not just a preparation for the celebration of the eucharist. A profound relationship exists between the two since the word of God and the bread of life are two aspects of the same mystery. "The Church has always venerated the divine Scriptures just as she venerates the body of the Lord, since from the table of both the word of God and the body of Christ she unceasingly receives and offers to the faithful the bread of life, especially in the sacred liturgy" (Constitution on Divine Revelation, art. 21). Jesus is the living word, the revelation of the Father. He is also the bread of life, the nourishment of his people. There is one personal self-giving. The liturgy of the word and the liturgy of the eucharist "form but one single act of worship" (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, art. 56).


