





UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Part 13 - The Liturgy of the Word - The Psalm Response

The responsorial psalm, the only psalm used in the Mass for its own sake and not to accompany an action, is primarily the assembly's response to the lesson which has just been proclaimed. The community uses God's word as a response to God's word. It is for this reason that the psalm may never be replaced by a text which is not from the psalter. To a

certain extent the psalm stimulates reflection upon God's saving deeds and thus somewhat serves as a prolongation of the reading

LIFELINE MINISTRY NEEDS YOUR HELP!


Lifeline is again running low on food, as we cannot rely on our usual bulk sources. Our "List of Preferred Foods" includes:




