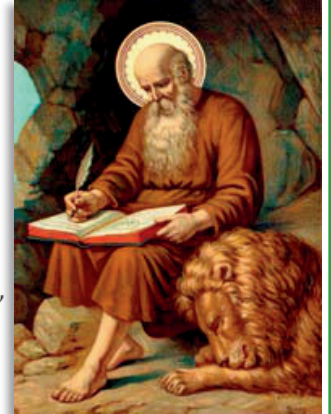

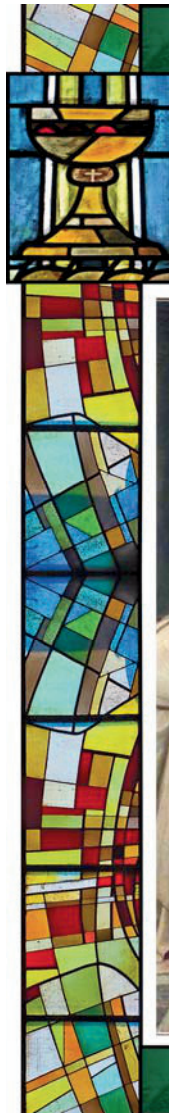

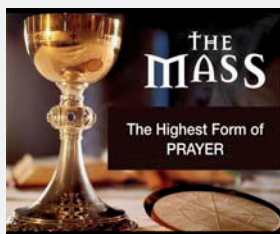
At present, I am finishing up my Master's Degree in Church Management through Villanova University. My graduation will take place next Spring.

Part 18 - The Liturgy of the Word - The Profession of Faith

ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASSES AND CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION



Are you an adult who has not yet celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation? Adult Catholics (ages 15 years and older) who have been baptized, received First Holy Communion and practicing their faith but have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation are Invited to participate in a preparation program.

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the individual's baptism is reinforced and sealed. This sacrament, like baptism, may only be celebrated once. It is closely linked with baptism in that there is an anointing with oil (Chrism), laying on of hands, and a special activity of the Holy Spirit. When celebrated apart from

Baptism and First Communion, the bishop or a priest designated by him is the minister of Confirmation.

The preparation program is comprised of six sessions in which you, the adult, will be advised of the process for this preparation and what is required of them. Sessions begin on Thursday, October 7, 2021.

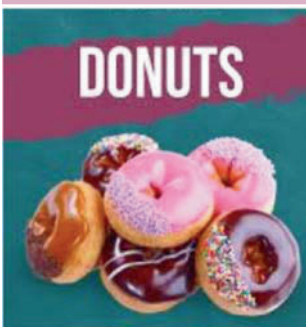

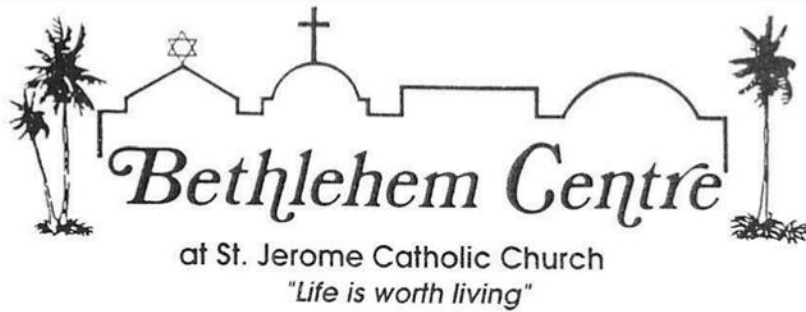

Exposition will be available on Livestream for those who wish to participate but not able to come to the church.

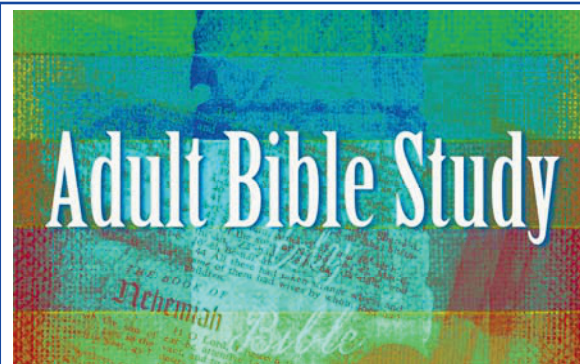
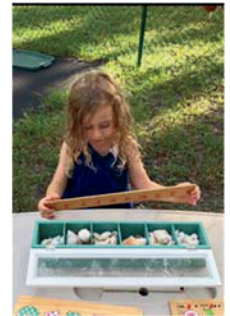
St. Jerome Early Childhood Center • 2021-22 School Year Open registration Quality Catholic Education for Children Ages 2-5

A MESSAGE FROM THE CENTER FOR DESEASE CONTROL

What You Need to Know

- COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective at preventing COVID-19 disease, especially severe illness and death.
- COVID-19 vaccines reduce the risk of people spreading the virus that causes COVID-19.
- You may have side effects after vaccination. These are normal and should go away in a few days.
- It typically takes 2 weeks after vaccination for the body to build protection (immunity) against the virus that causes COVID-19. You are not fully vaccinated until 2 weeks after the second dose of a 2-dose vaccine or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine.
- Learn how to find a COVID-19 vaccine so you can get it as soon as you can.
- After you are fully vaccinated, you can resume activities that you did before the pandemic. Learn more from the CDC about what you can do when you have been fully vaccinated.


