Fr. Tom's Column

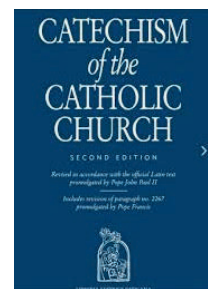
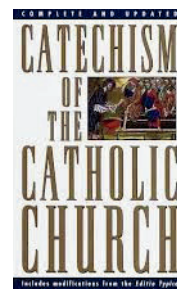


Dear Friends:

This Sunday we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. This year's theme is, "Say the Word and My Soul Shall be Healed." It has been said, that, "Generally speaking, no religious influence besides mom and dad is positioned to demonstrate convincingly to children the desirability of practicing the Catholic faith." The Catechism of the Catholic Church # 2688 states, "The catechesis of children, young people, and adults aims at teaching them to meditate on The Word of God in personal prayer, practicing it in liturgical prayer, and internalizing it at all times in order to bear fruit in a new life. Catechesis is also a time for the discernment and education of popular piety. The memorization of basic prayers offers an essential support to the life of prayer, but it is important to help learners savor their meaning. It is the primary call of parents in their own, 'Domestic Church,' to pass on the faith to their children but the call share the Faith is part of the life of every disciple of Jesus."

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Preparation of the Gifts
 21. The preparation of the altar and gifts, although the beginning of the eucharistic celebration, has a secondary character since it prepares for and leads to the eucharistic prayer. The altar is prepared; the gifts are "set apart" and presented as a sign of the community's desire to incorporate itself in the sacrifice of Christ; the bread and the wine are placed on the altar as the presider praises God for his gifts which will become the body and blood of the Lord; finally, in the prayer over the gifts the priest sums up the meaning of all that has taken place. The purpose of the rite is to prepare the altar, the gifts, and the community for the offering to come.

ALTAR FLOWERS - Flowers for the altar are available for a memorial of a loved one or a special intention of a family member or a friend. If you wish to donate the altar flowers for a particular weekend, please call the parish office at (727) 595-4610 and make arrangements with the receptionist.

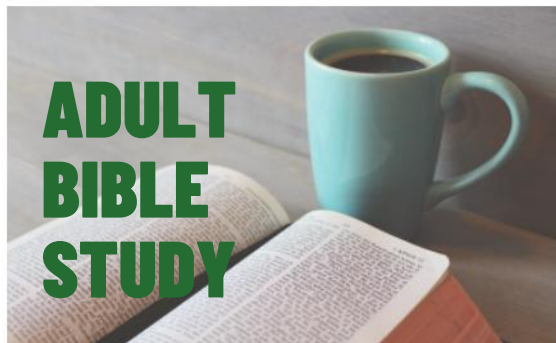

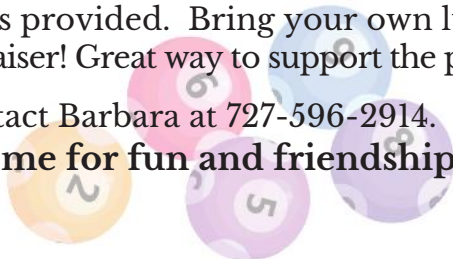

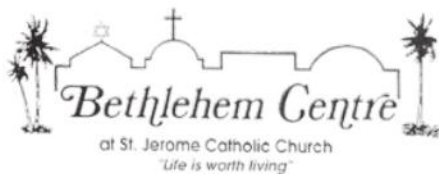

Adult Confirmation Classes

ARE YOU AN ADULT WHO HAS NOT BEEN CONFIRMED?

Adult Catholics (ages 15 years and above) who have been baptized, received First Holy Communion, and practicing their faith but have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation are invited to participate in a preparation program.

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the individual's baptism is reinforced and sealed. This sacrament, like baptism, may only be celebrated once. It is closely linked with Baptism in that there is an anointing with oil (Chrism), laying on of hands, and a special activity of the Holy Spirit. When celebrated apart from Baptism and First Communion, the bishop or a priest designated by him is the minister of Confirmation. The preparation program is comprised of six sessions in which you, the adult, will be advised of the process for this preparation and what is required of them.
