

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Offertory Song 24. The function of the offertory song is to accompany the procession and highlight its communal aspects. Texts expressing praise and joy as well as seasonal texts are appropriate. The song need not speak of bread and wine or of offering. To be avoided are texts that speak of offering completely apart from the action of Christ. Since the presentation and preparation of the gifts is a secondary rite, soft instrumental music or silence may be preferred as a more fitting psychological preparation for the eucharistic prayer.



Apostolic work currently being done by Legion members includes bringing Holy Communion to the homebound, visiting nursing home residents, teaching Faith Formation at RCIA, making phone calls to auxiliary members to check on how they are doing and praying a rosary before a funeral upon request.
