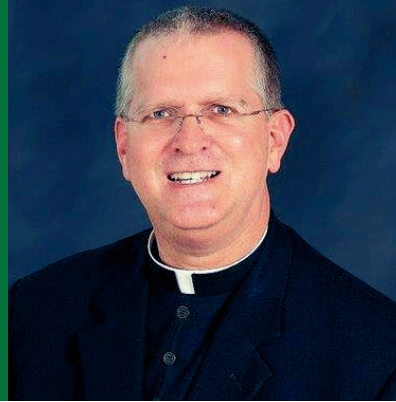

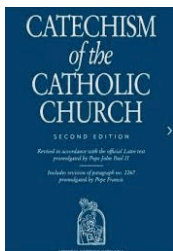

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

Offertory Song

24. The function of the offertory song is to accompany the procession and highlight its communal aspects. Texts expressing praise and joy as well as seasonal texts are appropriate. The song need not speak of bread and wine or of offering. To be avoided are texts that speak of offering completely apart from the action of Christ. Since the presentation and preparation of the gifts is a secondary rite, soft instrumental music or silence may be preferred as a more fitting psychological preparation for the eucharistic prayer.

Congratulations to Legion of Mary members here at St. Jerome, throughout the United States, and worldwide as they celebrated the 100th anniversary of the Legion's founding in Dublin on September 7, 1921!



The Legion of Mary is one of the largest lay organizations in the Catholic church with 4 million active members and 5 million auxiliary members (pre-pandemic numbers), and was founded by layman Frank Duff.

- **The goal of the Legion** is the personal holiness of its members, who take Mary as their model of holiness, and the performance of apostolic work.
- **Active members** perform 2 hours of apostolic work weekly and attend a weekly meeting (Thurs. at 10 am). Auxiliary members pray the Rosary and special Legion prayers each day which are needed to accomplish the work Mary is calling us to do.
- **Apostolic work** currently being done by Legion members includes bringing Holy Communion to the homebound, visiting nursing home residents, teaching Faith Formation at RCIA, making phone calls to auxiliary members to check on how they are doing and praying a rosary before a funeral upon request.
- **Legion activities** include an annual Mass of Consecration to Mary, annual retreat, and a holiday lunch.
