THIS WEEK'S UPDATE: Church just got brighter!

After two years of research and planning, our light issue in the church was finally fixed by Yarborough Electric on Friday, September 30th. The big ring above the sanctuary now works and we have installed LED lights. The smaller rings have also been fitted with LED lights, which will help drive our energy bill down. Additionally, the dimming issue has been solved by replacing the old panels with new ones. We are grateful for the hard work of several staff, volunteers, and donors involved who helped make this possible.

St. Jerome has re-formed a maintenance committee to work with Chris McBride, our new parish manager. The committee is made up of parishioners with special expertise in areas of the maintenance needs, and coordinates with the Finance Council to operate within our budget.

Our campus is large and there are seven buildings which require constant attention as well as landscape work. Due to the age of our facilities and new technologies, there is a lengthy list of projects that need attention.


