

Dear friends,

The 2020-2021 Fiscal Year was met with many blessings and challenges. The biggest blessing is that we have been able to return safely to celebrate Mass together after a period of uncertainty. We will continue to live-stream Masses each weekend to help those at home stay connected with our parish until they feel comfortable to return. Another blessing is that several of our ministries have begun to meet in person again, including our Preschool, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Bethlehem Centre, Social Outreach, Music Ministry, etc. It is good to see our parish community return safely. Please know of my constant and continued prayers for all of you.

The Annual Report on pages 3 & 4 shows the financial health of our parish. As you may know, our biggest challenge this fiscal year is to avoid drawing from our savings account. For the past 3 years we have drawn over \$147,000 out of Parish Savings to cover our day-to-day operations. We have made a strong effort to stay financially healthy through the pandemic by obtaining a PPP loan and reducing administrative cost, but we are still expecting a shortfall. If every parish family gives an extra \$12 a month, then we will be able to break even without drawing from savings. I kindly ask you to continue to support our parish with courage and hope as we move forward in faith during this new Fiscal Year.

Finally, thank you for keeping our young friend Henry, featured in last week's bulletin, in your prayers as he desires to be adopted into a forever family. You can learn more about him on page 4.








# FINANCIAL REPORT (CON'T)







This represents the financial information for the parish for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2021. Total operating revenues are down \$79,425 or 4.8% from the prior year primarily due to reduction in APA Collections. Total Operating expenses are also down \$112.008 or 6.6% from the prior year due to reductions in administrative and facility costs offset by an increase in APA payments. Our APA Assessment this year was \$241,543 and was paid prior to year end with approximately \$150,000 from savings. We ended the year with an operating loss of \$29,572 and a reduction in cash of \$129,195. We have also collected \$169,035 this year towards our Raise the Roof Campaign.

## St. Jerome parish is praying that Henry finds his forever home.



## MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE

**THIS WEEK'S UPDATE:** "We are pleased to share that the coil for our church air conditioning has been installed successfully by Griffin Service Corporation. This completes the necessary work we needed to ensure our air conditioner works efficiently so that we can comfortably worship in the church. The total expenses were \$17,530 which included the coil, phase monitors, fuse, valve, oil solenoid and labor. While it took extra time to get parts due to the national logiam, we are impressed with Griffin's work and attention to detail during the entire process. We are also thankful to donors who contributed to this repair. Without the assistance of our donors, it may have taken longer to complete this work. We are very grateful!"


