

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS: EPICLESIS

34. To sanctify is a role proper to the Holy Spirit who completes and brings to fullness the work of the Father and the Son. It is through the power of the Spirit, who integrates the gifts of the people into the offering of Christ, that the church presents to the Father the memorial of the Son and efficaciously repeats the words of institution. It is also through the Holy Spirit that the Church constantly becomes the body of Christ, nourished and fortified by his presence in the eucharist. Both gifts and people are transformed by the power of the Spirit; the gifts become the signs of Christ's sacramental presence as food; the people enter into communion with Christ and each other.




