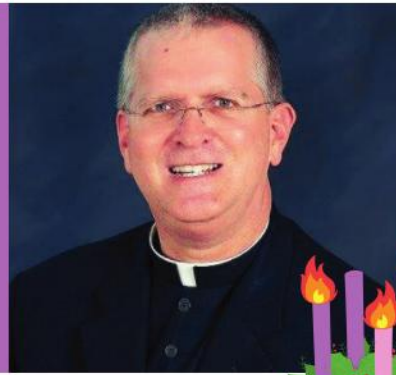

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS: PREFACE

32. In this solemn beginning of the Eucharistic prayer the whole assembly through the priest blesses or praises God for his wonderful works of creation and redemption. Focusing attention on a particular mystery or aspect of salvation history or giving a quick glance at some mystery or feast being celebrated, the preface is the keynote for the praise and thanksgiving which permeate the whole Eucharistic prayer. In the introductory dialogue the assembly is made conscious of its close union with the presiding priest, who speaks in the name of all. This dialogue parallels the Amen at the conclusion of the prayer: both manifest the ecclesial unity of all who praise the Father through the Son.

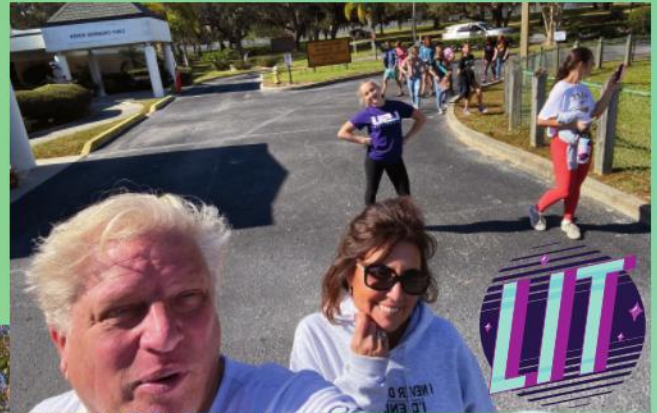

Altar Serving Training Calling all fully initiated Catholics!



Altar server training is available for those wishing to be Altar Servers at St. Jerome.

The server is a member of the assembly who assists the priest and deacon during the Eucharist and other liturgical ceremonies so that the liturgy can be conducted with grace and reverence. Servers should be active and full participants in the celebration. Ideally, servers are fully initiated Catholics. Altar Servers MUST have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist; youths who have not been confirmed may serve. Recommended minimum age for youth is roughly the fourth grade.

Servers are expected to be appropriately prepared, committed to giving their time and talent to their parish community, and willing to serve God's people. They should be able to understand the Eucharistic celebration and the other sacred rites.
