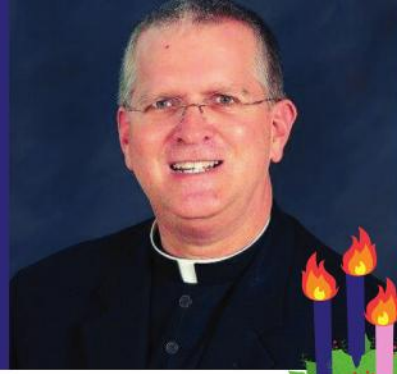

Pray at Home

Prayer for Expectant Mothers During the Christmas Season

+ Sign of the Cross

Prayer: Lord God, Creator of the human race, your Son, through the working of the Holy Spirit, was born of a woman, so that He might pay the age-old debt of sin and save us by His redemption. Receive with kindness the prayer of your servant as she asks for the birth of a healthy child. Grant that she may safely deliver a son or daughter to serve you in all things, and to gain eternal life. We ask this through Christ the Lord.

All: Amen + Sign of the Cross

Prayers for the Home: Christmas Tree

When all have gathered, a suitable song may be sung. The leader makes the sign of the cross, and all reply "Amen." The leader may greet those present in the following words: Let us glorify Christ our light, who brings salvation and peace into our midst, now and forever. *R/. Amen.*

In the following or similar words, the leader prepares those present for the blessing:

My brothers and sisters, amidst signs and wonders Christ Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea: his birth brings joy to our hearts and enlightenment to our minds. With this tree, decorated and adorned, may we welcome Christ among us; may its lights guide us to the perfect light. One of those present or the leader reads a text of sacred Scripture, for example, Titus 3:4 (lines 4-7) or Ezekiel 17:22 (lines 22-24 4; I will plant a tender shoot on the mountain heights of Israel.)

Reader: The Word of the Lord. *R/. Thanks be to God.*

The intercessions are then said. The leader says: Let us ask God to send his blessing upon us and upon this sign of our faith in the Lord. *R/. Lord, give light to our hearts.*

That this tree of lights may remind us of the tree of glory on which Christ accomplished our salvation, let us pray to the Lord. *R/.*

That the joy of Christmas may always be in our homes, let us pray to the Lord. *R/.*

That the peace of Christ may dwell in our hearts and in the world, let us pray to the Lord. *R/.*

After the intercessions the leader invites all present to say the Lord's Prayer. The leader says the prayer with hands joined: Lord our God, we praise you for the light of creation: the sun, the moon, and the stars of the night. We praise you for the light of Israel: the Law, the prophets, and the wisdom of the Scriptures. We praise you for Jesus Christ, your Son: he is Emmanuel, God-with-us, the Prince of Peace, who fills us with the wonder of your love.

Lord God, let your blessing come upon us as we illumine this tree. May the light and cheer it gives be a sign of the joy that fills our hearts. May all who delight in this tree come to the knowledge and joy of salvation. We ask this through Christ our Lord. *R/. Amen.* The lights of the tree are then illuminated. The leader concludes the rite by signing himself or herself with the sign of the cross and saying: May the God of glory fill our hearts with peace and joy, now and forever. *R/. Amen.* The blessing concludes with a verse from "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel": —From "Catholic Household Blessings & Prayers"

Prayers for the Home: Manger

All make the sign of the cross as the leader says: Our help is in the name of the Lord. *R/. Who made heaven and earth.*

One of those present or the leader reads a text of sacred Scripture, for example, Luke 2:1 (lines 1-8) or Isaiah 7:10 (lines 10-15, the birth of Emmanuel).

Reader: The Gospel of the Lord. *R/. Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.*

The leader prays with hands joined: God of every nation and people, from the very beginning of creation you have made manifest your love: when our need for a Savior was great you sent your Son to be born of the Virgin Mary. To our lives he brings joy and peace, justice, mercy, and love.

Lord, bless all who look upon this manger; may it remind us of the humble birth of Jesus, and raise our thoughts to him, who is God-with-us and Savior of all, and who lives and reigns forever and ever. *R/. Amen.* —From "Catholic Household Blessings & Prayers"

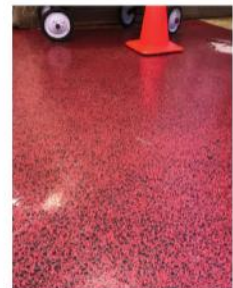
DID YOU KNOW?

Congress has permanently enacted qualified charitable distributions from your traditional IRA accounts. These distributions can be used to satisfy all or a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution. These distributions are free of federal and state income tax. Additionally, these gifts help you avoid the Medicare high income surcharge and can help to reduce taxes on your social security benefits. MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE

THIS WEEK'S UPDATE: Since the renovation of our church back in 2011, we have had issues with the red epoxy terrazzo floor in the church, especially the Gathering Space where there is significant damage as seen in this image. This occurred due to the red color glass in the epoxy terrazzo caused the moisture vapor membrane to fail. This caused the floor to fail. After significant discussions and negotiations with Karcher Construction and Artistic Surfaces, we were able to settle on a price and rough timeline to replace the red epoxy terrazzo floor in the church. St. Jerome will pick up 1/3 of the cost which will total \$23,000. The floor will be replaced next June or July. We are thankful for Karcher Construction and our Maintenance Committee for helping us make progress so that our church is safe and welcoming for all.

Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.

For those concerned about attending Sunday Mass with large numbers the following Masses tend to have fewer people: Saturday: 5:30pm - Sunday: 7:30am & 12:30pm



Altar Serving Training: *Calling all fully initiated Catholics!*

Altar server training is available for those wishing to be Altar Servers at St. Jerome.

The server is a member of the assembly who assists the priest and deacon during the Eucharist and other liturgical ceremonies so the liturgy may be conducted with grace and reverence. Servers should be active and full participants in the celebration. Ideally, servers are fully initiated Catholics. Altar Servers MUST have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist; youths who have not been confirmed may serve. Recommended minimum age for youth is roughly the fourth grade.

Servers are expected to be appropriately prepared, committed to giving their time and talent to their parish community, and willing to serve God's people. They should be able to understand the Eucharistic celebration and the other sacred rites. For more info or to schedule a training, contact Trisha Patterson 727-743-3071

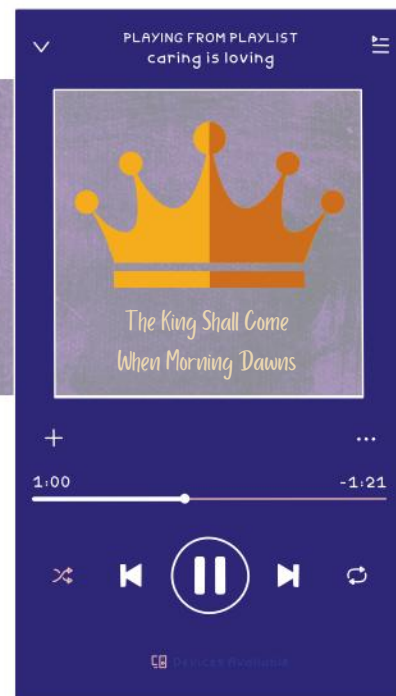
