



Jesus told St. Faustina that this feast of Mercy would be a very special day when all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened (Diary 699). The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated on the Sunday following Easter and is now called Divine Mercy Sunday.

Resus, I trust in You.


Our Lord made as great promise: "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. " (Diary 699). He went on to say, "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy." (Diary 1109). The Church allows for one to go to Confession for up to about 20 days, before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.

We will celebrate Divine Mercy at all of our Sunday Masses this weekend, and our "Divine Mercy Holy Hour" will take place on Sunday at 3:00pm, April 24th.



Understanding the Mass: Silent Prayer/Song of Praise


52. Although a hymn of praise or a psalm may be sung by the entire congregation after the communion, adequate time for deep and silent prayer should not be rare. Such silence is important to the total rhythm of the celebration.







Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.


