

ANNOUNCEMENTS (EFFECTIVE MONDAY, AUGUST 1, 2022)

- Masks will continue to be available for Sunday Mass on the baptismal font in the Church and at the back of the Chapel for Daily Mass for those needing to wear a mask.
- The wearing of masks by those distributing Holy Communion will now be optional.
- We will resume the distribution of Holy Communion on the tongue on the part of all those distributing Holy Communion.
- The person distributing Holy Communion at the statue of Mary (for Sunday Mass and at the back of the chapel for Daily Mass) will continue to wear a mask. (This will allow for anyone who might have a concern for their health to receive Holy Communion in this way).
- The station at the statue of Mary for our Sunday Masses and at the back of the Chapel for our Daily Masses will now become the station for those who would like to receive a low gluten host.



In light of the recent Supreme Court decision, we are continuing to highlight this month some of the resources available to those in need with an unexpected or difficult pregnancy. PINELLAS HOPE

Sometimes, life is really hard, and obstacles feel insurmountable. In those moments, it can become difficult to hold a job, and thus housing can become a real vulnerability. Our diocese created Pinellas Hope and Hillsborough Hope to help combat homelessness in their respective regions. These Hope ministries provide village style temporary housing for several months and assistance in getting a job so as to help residents get back on their feet. There are community classes where different skills are learned, including coping mechanisms, and the local community of parishes takes turns cooking and providing meals for residents.

If you'd like to donate to Pinellas Hope or Hillsborough Hope, be it funds, teaching a class, or providing a meal (usually the most immediate need), see here: https://pinellashope.org.
Hillsborough Hope recently expressed urgent need for meals.

Did you know: Pinellas Hope was founded in 2007, and Hillsborough Hope began as a Covid response initiative in 2020 in partnership with the City of Tampa with a temporary space, now permanent as of 2021! This is in direct response to YOUR tithing and our Diocese!

F.A.S.T. - FAITH & ACTION FOR STRENGTH TOGETHER

Our Diocesan Office of Life, Justice & Advocacy has been involved for many years with FAST, a local interfaith initiative for highlighting and advocating for the needs of those who struggle in our area. 



Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.




