Labor Day in the United States is a public holiday celebrated on the first Monday of September. It honors the American Labor movement and the contributions that workers have made to the strength, prosperity, laws and well-being of our country. St. John Paul II, reminds us that, "work is a good thing for man – a good thing for his humanity-because through work man not only transforms nature, adapting it to his own needs, but he also achieves fulfillment as a human being and indeed, in a sense, becomes more a human being." (On Human Work: Laborem Exercens) "Human work proceeds directly from persons created in the image of God and called to prolong the work of creation by subduing the earth, both with and for one another. Hence work is a duty: "If any one will not work, let him not eat." Work honors the Creator's gifts and talents received from Him." #2427 Catechism of the Catholic Church. In addition, we recall that Jesus was known as the "carpenter's son," and spent a greater part of His life in manual labor. We honor this weekend all who labor for our good.

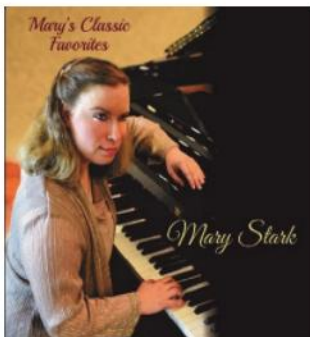

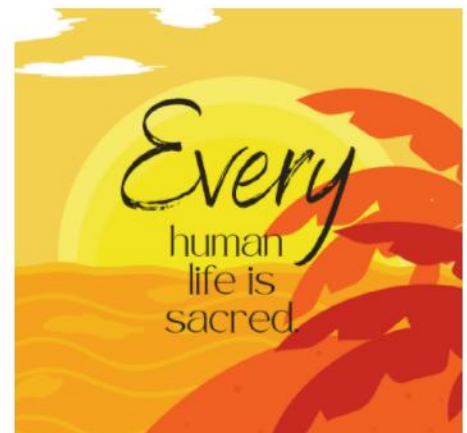

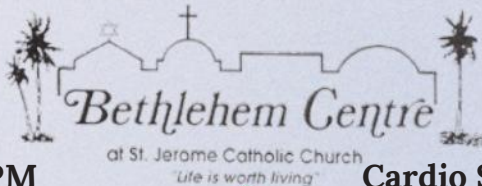
