

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

World Mission Sunday, the annual, worldwide Eucharistic celebration for the missions of the Church, will be on the weekend of October 22-23, 2022. This important day in the life of the Church strengthens our understanding of our shared call to mission, bestowed upon us at baptism.

Pope Francis' message for World Mission Sunday reflects on the theme: You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8). The Holy Father shares his zeal, reminding us that, "as Christians, we cannot keep the Lord to ourselves," as we "recall with gratitude all those men and women who by their testimony of life help us to renew our baptismal commitment to be generous and joyful apostles of the Gospel."

World Mission Sunday provides us with that very opportunity. We can speak about our faith and respond to our missionary call through prayer, participation in the Eucharist, and giving generously to the collection for the Church's missionary work. Your gifts support and sustain priests, religious and lay pastoral leaders in more than 1,100 mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe as they proclaim the Gospel, build the Church, serve the poor – and speak of our shared faith in all corners of the world.

Please be assured of my gratitude for your prayerful solidarity with those in mission territories and for your generous participation in the missionary work of the Church.
