Dear Friends:

The Church teaches that “...the liturgy of Advent each year...makes present [the] ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior’s first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for His second coming.”
#524 Catechism of the Catholic Church

We are assisted both in our church and our homes to be mindful of our awaiting the arrival of the Messiah through the use of the ‘Advent Wreath.’ The Advent Wreath has German origins and is probably the most recognized Advent custom. It is a wreath made of evergreens that is bound to a circle of wire. It symbolizes the many years from Adam to Christ in which the world awaited the Redeemer. It also represents the years that we have and will await His second and final coming. The wreath holds four equally spaced candles, the three purple ones lit on the Sundays of expectation and a rose one for the joyful Third Sunday in Advent.



We begin this weekend at all of our Sunday Masses, the custom of our “Tree of Hope.” We thank our parishioners who will share with us a symbol of hope in their lives.

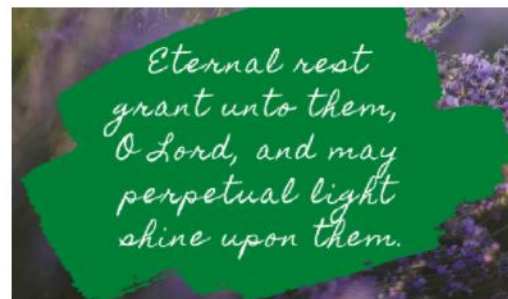

RAISE THE ROOF

A solid, lasting future

Shortly before the COVID-19 pandemic began, St. Jerome launched the "Raise the Roof" capital campaign to provide much-needed funds to replace the church roof. During that campaign, however, we experienced not just COVID, but severe economic concerns, hyper-inflation, hurricanes, and other challenges. Despite all that, Mass attendance is returning, and our final position is improving. In addition, we met our initial campaign goal of \$600,000.

Our pastor, Fr. Tom Morgan, is so appreciative of all of you for your continuing generosity in supporting our parish and Diocese during the past three years. But there is more work to be done. These last two hurricanes have put added stress on the church roof and have made it imperative at this point to raise the remaining funds to replace the roof – soon and very soon!

Prior to starting our campaign, our Building and Maintenance Committee determined that replacing our shingled church roof with a metal roof was our best choice for several reasons. First, the warranty for a metal roof is at least 40 years, which is over double the lifespan of a shingle roof. Second, metal roofs withstand category 4 hurricanes with 150 mph winds and 180 mph gusts. Third, metal roofs have reflective properties making them energy efficient which can reduce cooling costs by as much as 25%. The extra longevity and strength that a metal roof provides over a shingle roof makes it worth the extra roughly \$300,000.

Due to inflationary pressures, our roof project will now cost us about \$1.4 million. The goal of the campaign is to raise the remaining funds of a little under \$800,000 by the end of December 2023, so that we can begin replacement of the roof in the first quarter of 2024, the slower time for roofers which could provide discounts on the costs.

You might be thinking that one year is a significantly short time, but it is imperative to get our new roof on and avoid the continued costs of patching an already worn-out roof. We know St. Jerome to be a place where parishioners come to be fed by the Lord and, in turn, are eager to support the needs of the parish. Our time is now and if we collectively support our new campaign, we WILL HAVE that new roof in early 2024. Pledge envelopes are at the end of each pew and more information will be mailed to each family. Thank you for your continued support and may God bless our efforts!

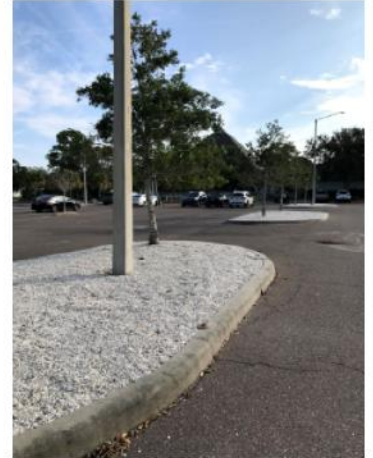

Did You Know?

Congress has permanently enacted qualified charitable distributions from your traditional IRA accounts. These distributions can be used to satisfy all or a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution. These distributions are free of federal and state income tax. Additionally, these gifts help you avoid the Medicare high income surcharge and can help to reduce taxes on your social security benefits. Distributions must be made directly from your IRA account to St. Jerome.

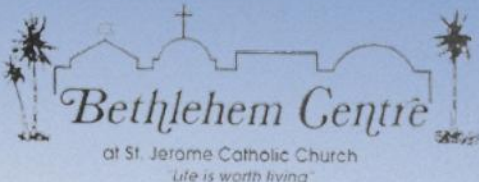
