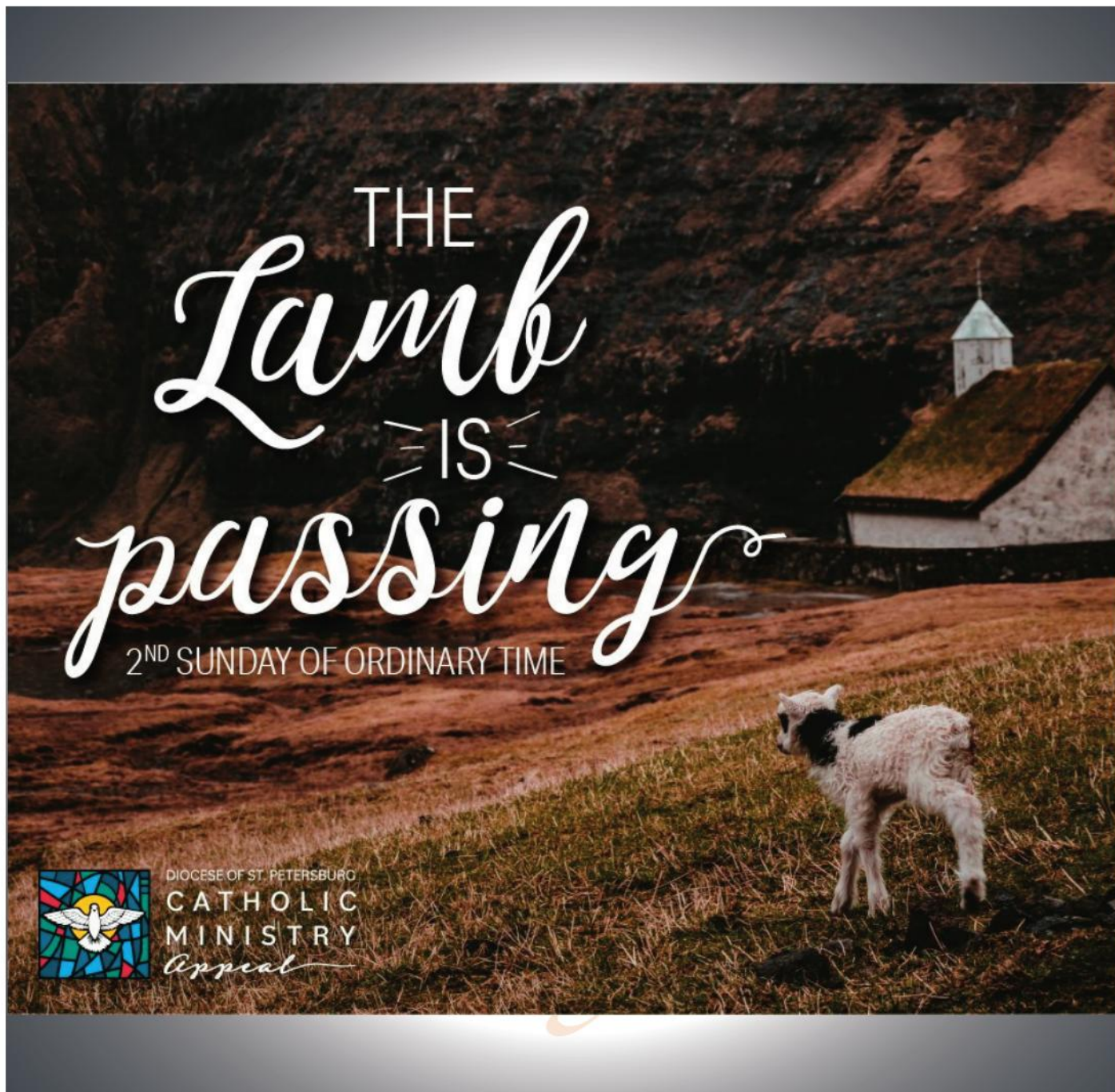

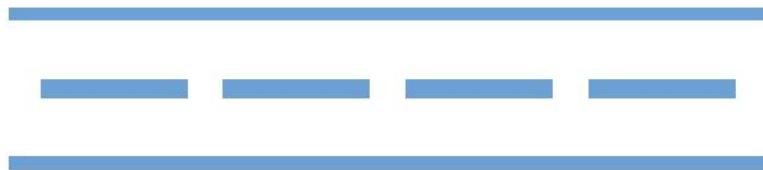

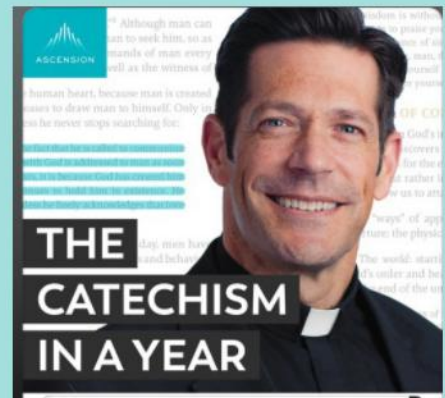

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

A metal roof has reflective properties which can save us up to 25% on energy cost for our church building. Our energy bill for the church building averages \$5,000 a month. Thus, a metal roof could cut our energy bill cost as much as \$1,250 a month which comes out to \$15,000 a year. Over the course of a 40-year warranty, the metal roof could save us as much as \$600,000. This is a very attractive benefit to replacing our shingle roof with a metal roof.

We are working hard towards the goal of **\$1.4 million**. Thank you for making a pledge today so we can expeditiously complete this needed project!

Last week Lifeline served 66 families comprised of 193 people. Parishioners donated 133 bags of food. During 2022, we served 5,016 families comprised of 16,560 people (1,587 families more than 2021). Community members donated 9,285 bags of food in 2021. In addition to food, we received many generous cash donations throughout the year. 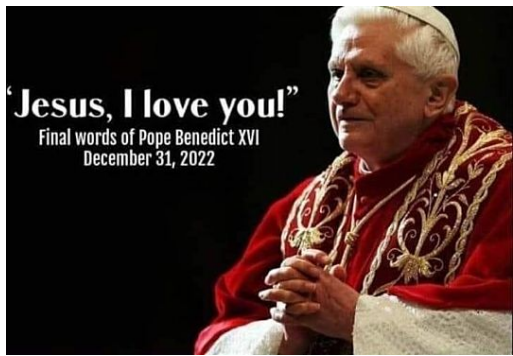
