Dahl Recipe — Bangladesh

Start to Finish: 30 minutes

Serves: 4-6

Ingredients

- 2 cups dried red lentils, rinsed
- 4 cups water
- 2 teaspoons ground turmeric
- 1 tablespoon fresh ginger, minced
- 2 cinnamon sticks
- 2 teaspoons ground cardamom
- 3-4 bay leaves
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- Vegetable oil
- 1 small red onion, chopped
- 1 tablespoon garlic, chopped
- Chopped cilantro



In a large pot, add lentils with 4 cups water and bring to boil. Once boiling, reduce heat to a simmer. Add turmeric power, ginger, cinnamon sticks, cardamom & bay leaves to the lentils and cook for 15 minutes, or until lentils are tender. Remove pot from the stove and add salt. In a separate pan, heat vegetable oil and add chopped onions and garlic, sauteeing until light brown. Add sauteed onions and garlic to the lentils. Garnish with freshly chopped cilantro. Serve with rice.

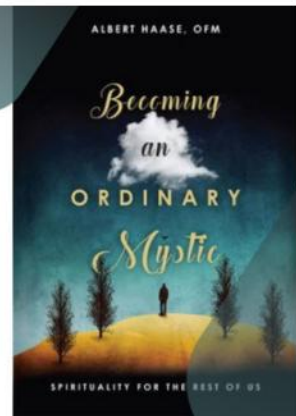

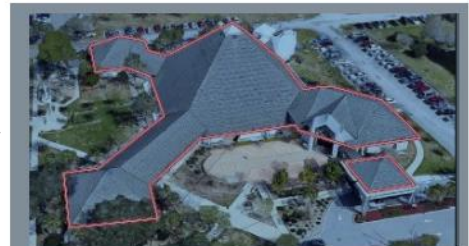

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

A metal roof has reflective properties which can save us up to 25% on energy cost for our church building. Our energy bill for the church building averages \$5,000 a month. Thus, a metal roof could cut our energy bill cost as much as \$1,250 a month which comes out to \$15,000 a year. Over the course of a 40-year warranty, the metal roof could save us as much as \$600,000. This is a very attractive benefit to replacing our shingle roof with a metal roof.

Did You Know?
