

FROM THE PASTOR - FR. TOM MORGAN

Dear Friends:

- Jesus loves you so much that He comes to you in this Sacrament because He desires to be close to you.
- Always seek to be close to Jesus by visiting Him whenever you can at our chapel which is always open. Jesus is filled with joy when you visit Him. If you pass a Catholic church and are at the time unable to visit Jesus who waits for your visit in the tabernacle, bow your head or make the sign of the cross as you pass the church. Jesus is always thinking of you and this shows that you are thinking of Him and that you truly are His friend.
- Jesus calls you every week as our “Good Shepherd” to come to church either to a Saturday Vigil Mass or a Mass on Sunday to listen to what He wants to say to you and to receive Him once again in Holy Communion.
- Remember, for Jesus to enable you to receive Him in Holy Communion, He had to be born in Bethlehem, live, die on the Cross, and rise on Easter Sunday. Please always be grateful for the great gift Jesus has given you in giving you His very self.

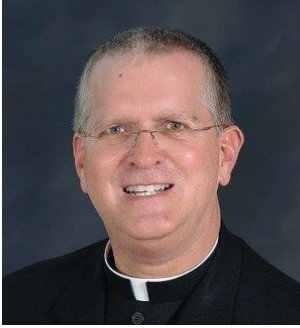

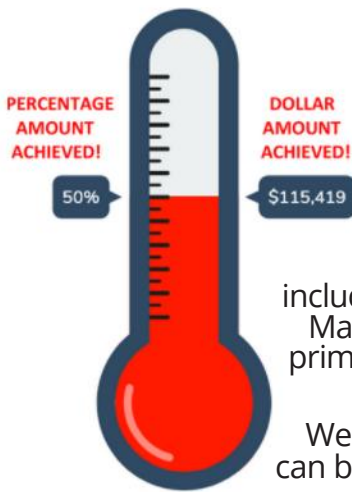

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

The proposed roof for the church building will be a standing seam metal roof that will provide a useful life in excess of forty years. One of the biggest benefits of standing seam roofing is the hidden fastener system it uses. The hidden (or concealed fasteners), refers to the clips, screws or nails being hidden from view on the installed standing seam roof. A key benefit of hidden fasteners is not puncturing the standing seam metal panel itself, nor is it exposed to weather which could cause them to fail over time. This usually means the standing seam metal roof has a higher level of protection from the elements, will require less maintenance, and will provide a more attractive and appealing look for the standing seam roof.
