Dear brothers and sisters,

During this month of November, we turn our attention to the souls of the faithful departed who are in Purgatory undergoing the final purification of the elect. This is celebrated liturgically with our Commemoration of All Souls November 2, highlighted by our annual All Souls Remembrance Mass as we especially prayed for the members of our parish family who died this past year.



The holy souls are friends of God who have died in His Grace and are assured of Heaven, but who are not yet spiritually 'clean' enough to enter into Heaven. Their wedding garments are still stained with the imperfections, vices, and attachments to sin that need to be washed away so they can achieve the purity needed to be received into the wedding feast of the Lamb.

These holy souls are often referred to as the Church Suffering because their temporary separation from God and from the Beatific Vision is a cause of great pain. However, the suffering is not punitive, but purgative. Like gold tested in fire, the suffering experienced is the purgation of all the spiritual impurities and imperfections that ultimately lead to purification and entrance into the fellowship of the Church Triumphant in Heaven.

We, the Church Militant on earth, have the awesome opportunity and obligation to assist the holy souls with our prayers, sacrifices and good works in order to help them reach their final destination...Heaven.

And so, let us renew our commitment this month to pray for the souls in Purgatory when we are at Mass, when we pray the rosary, even when we pray grace before meals. In my family, we add to the conclusion of our grace before meals: *"...and may the souls of the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. Amen."* A simple yet effective way to remember and pray for the holy souls.

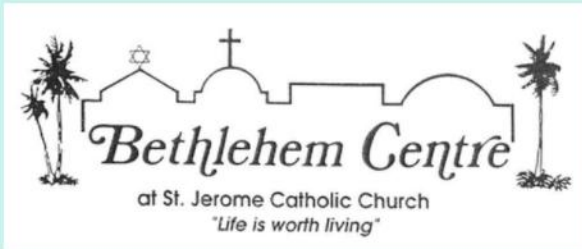

ST. JEROME HEALTH MINISTRY

What is a Health Ministry?

A health ministry promotes whole-person health and healing — body, mind and spirit. It includes a wide variety of faith community services, from coordinating blood pressure checks and other health screenings to helping people find health resources to visiting the sick and homebound. A health ministry can be organized in whatever way best meets the health and wellness needs of the congregation and neighborhood it serves.

What is a Health Minister?

(Also called Health Ambassador, Congregational Health Promoter, Health Advocate, etc.) Health ministries often are led by faith community members who have a deep spiritual calling to serve others through the promotion of health, healing and wholeness. A professional health or ministry background is not required, although some health ministries are led by healthcare professionals. Health ministers come from a variety of medical and non-medical backgrounds and occupations. Health ministers believe in the importance of whole person health in the role of faith communities and other faith-based agencies. Often, they are part of a health and wellness ministry or team. Some may work alone while others may work with faith community nurses to organize, plan, and evaluate health ministry activities.

What does the Health Ministry of St Jerome do?

Here at St Jerome we have a health ministry composed of members with various backgrounds in the health field. We sponsor monthly free community educational seminars covering a vast array of useful topics. Each February we hold a health fair where parishioners can gain information and access to local community healthcare practitioners, agencies and services. Along with our partners at Baycare Faith Community Nursing we offer free monthly blood pressure screenings and can assist with obtaining healthcare services where they may otherwise be unable to due to finances, transportation, or other restrictive factors.

How can you help?

We are always seeking members with healthcare backgrounds and experience to plan and assist with activities. Specialists are always welcome to speak at our lectures. Healthcare and non healthcare help is always welcome at the annual Health Fair.

Thank you! We hope to see you at our events or to be able to assist you with any healthcare challenges.

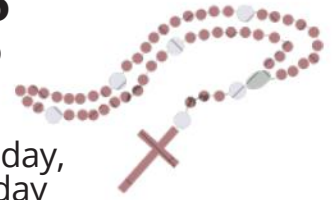
