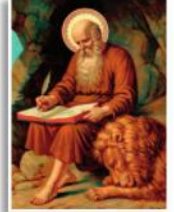

It has been my experience as a pastor that parishioners are more than willing to share their opinions. I have always been inspired by a quote from Pope Pius XII used in the Second Vatican Council document, *Lumen Gentium*, which says that:



*"... the faithful are, by reason of the knowledge, competence or outstanding ability which they may enjoy, permitted and sometimes even obliged to express their opinion on those things which concern the good of the Church." (#37) I would invite all to take seriously this call to share our thoughts for the good of our parish, but we need more than just opinions we need people "to step up to the plate."*

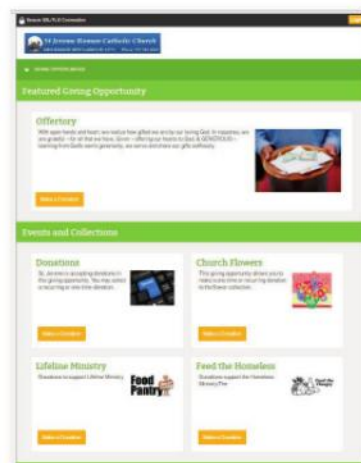

The goal of the Readers Ministry is to provide dedicated and well prepared readers of the Word for every Mass offered in our parish.



Readers are members of the Assembly who proclaim the Word in the first two scripture readings and are the first to deliver the Word at Mass. We are proud to have over 60 dedicated readers.

Becoming a reader is a serious decision and commitment to your faith and parish, since you are sharing your time and energy to the service of the church.

Training and preparation are necessary for those persons wishing to be readers. Proclaiming the Sacred Scripture is different from other kinds of public speaking. Not only do readers need to be effective communicators, but they need to absorb and express the spirit of the Liturgy as well. Training is provided on an individual basis.

Vatican II said, "They (readers) exercise a genuine liturgical function. They ought, therefore, to discharge their office with the sincere piety and decorum demanded by so exalted a ministry and right expected of them by God's people. Consequently, they must all be trained to perform their functions in a correct and orderly manner... Christ is present in His word since it is He Himself who speaks when the Holy Scriptures are read in the church."

In keeping with the generosity of our church, if you bring in a can or a box of food for the poor, we will give you a free bingo card for a special game. One card per can every week!

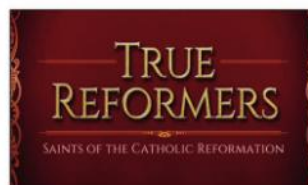
