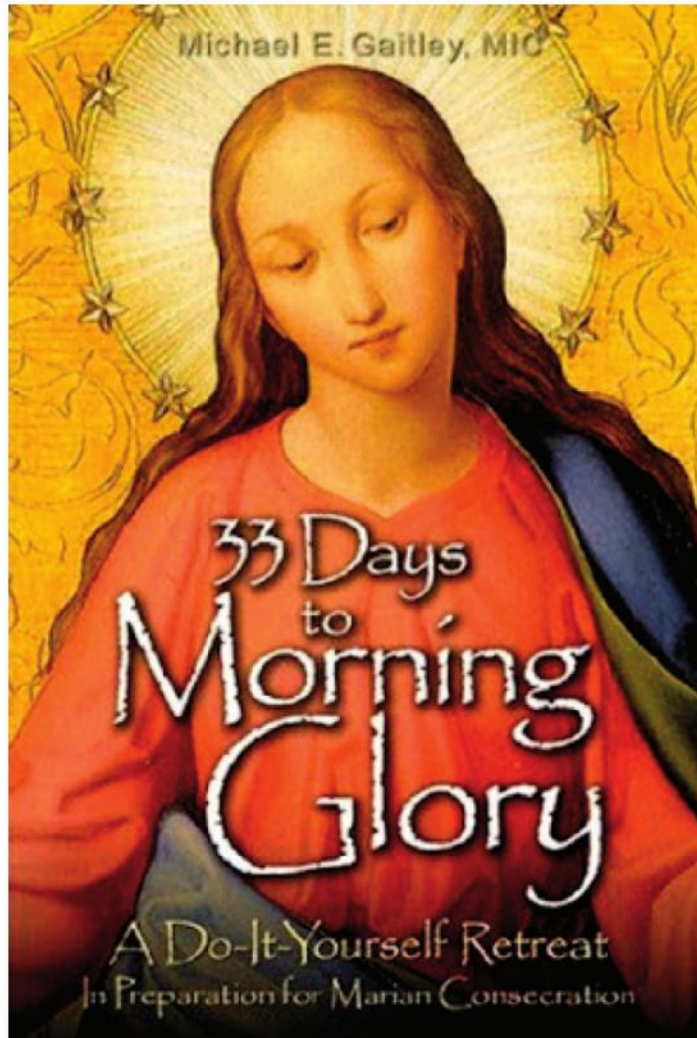
Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary
