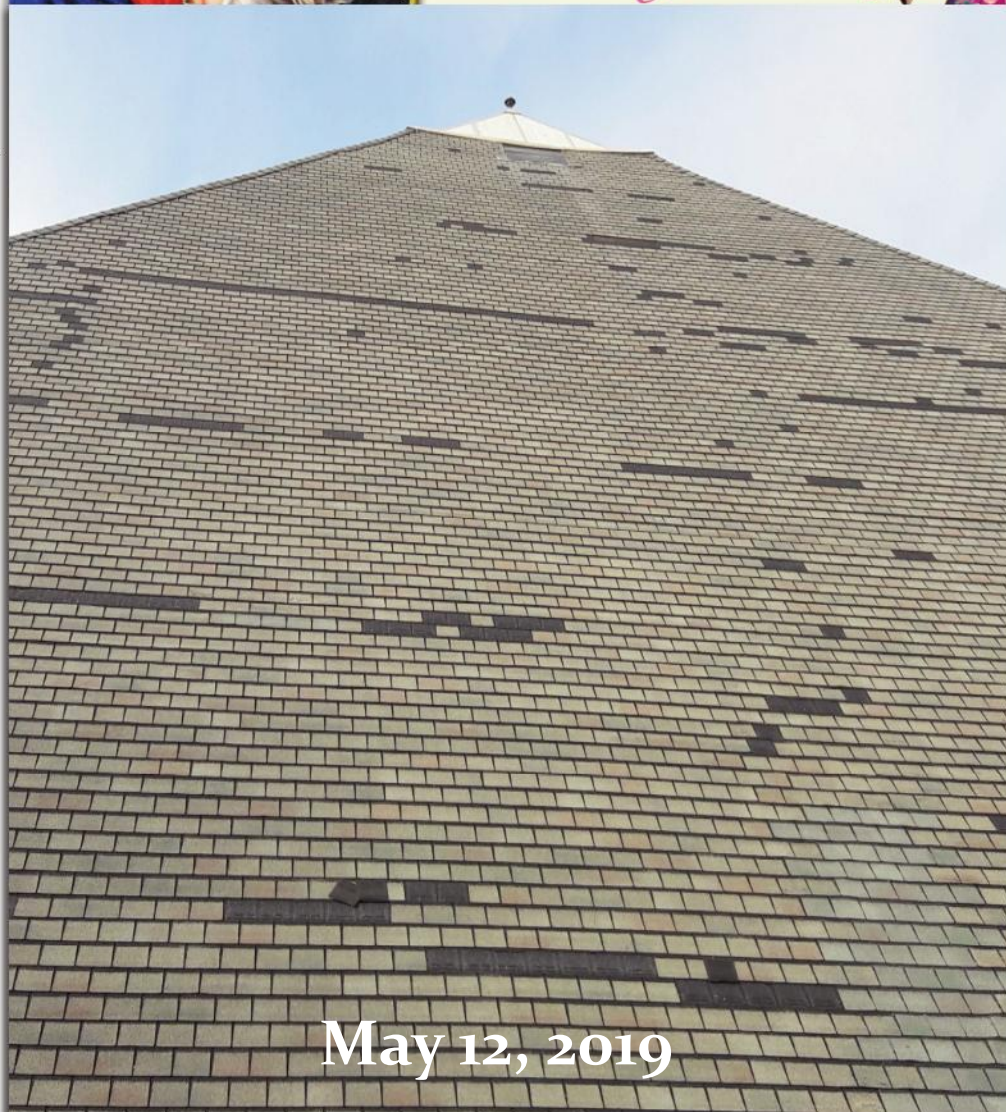

Announcing our Roof Q & A!!!

The weekend of May 18th & 19th Finance Council members will be available in the Holy Family Chapel after all weekend Masses for Roof Question & Answer sessions. As mentioned recently, St. Jerome is in need of a new church roof and has proposed replacing the current shingle roof with a metal roof.

St. Jerome Parish Roofing Issues Q and A

1. **Didn't we just have roof repaired after Hurricane Irma? Was the repair of the roof done properly?**
Yes, shingle replacement and repairs were made last summer after Irma. The repairs were done properly.
2. **Why does the roof have to be replaced?**
The roof is old and the shingles are dried out, brittle and curled as the heat and wind in Florida are very hard on asphalt shingle roofs. As a result, the shingles catch the wind. The steepness/slope of the roof also aggravates the situation.
3. **Can the roof replacement be delayed, since it was recently repaired?**
All options are being reviewed. However, the roof continues to deteriorate with each major wind event. St. Jerome's is in a high Wind Zone, and as these events occur, the roof continues to lose significant numbers of shingles increasing the likelihood of leaks which will cause damage to the interior of the church.
4. **How long did the current roof last?**
The shingle roof on the Church was replaced in 2004.
5. **Was there a warranty on the current roof?**
Yes, there was a ten-year warranty for materials only which expired in 2014.
6. **Are we utilizing outside expert consultants?**
Yes, we are utilizing the expertise of the Diocese, outside consultants and parishioners. The outside consultant has recommended that the roof both on the Church and Parish Center roof be replaced due to their current condition.
7. **Why metal for church roof?**
Metal is one of the best alternatives for the High Wind Zone events the Church is now experiencing. Metal is capable of withstanding 140 mph + gusts and last up to 40 years.
8. **How will replacing our Church roof affect our finances?**
The Church metal roof is a significant undertaking which could cost up to \$850,000. This requires the oversight of a consultant to insure the specifications are met.
The cost of financing the new Church roof will require a significant increase in our revenue. Increasing our offertory and "Raise the roof" gifts will be required to cover the cost. The monthly payment to cover the existing loan on the church renovations is \$8,900. It is estimated that refinancing of the existing loan along with the additional cost of replacing the church roof will result in a new monthly payment between \$11,000 and \$12,000.
9. **How does this fit in with other goals we are pursuing in light of Bishop Parkes "Courageously Living the Gospel?"**
We are committed as a Parish and Diocese to Living into our Courageously Living the Gospel commitments. Replacing our Church roof cannot be allowed to affect this Holy purpose.
10. **What can parishioners do?**
Support your Parish by increasing your offertory and supporting the "Raise the Roof" campaign directed toward replacing the roof of our house of worship.
