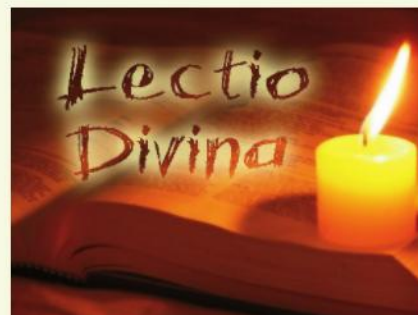

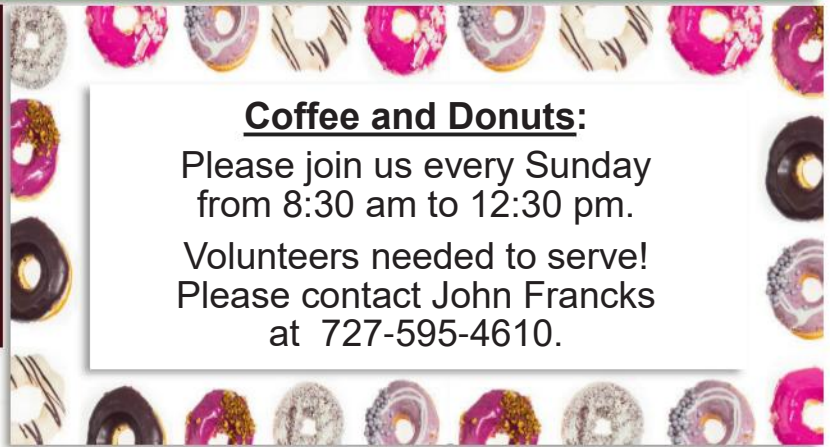

THE SPIRITUAL CHILD by Lisa Miller, Ph. D.



Opportunities for Spiritual Parenting

“The thousands of moments shared with our children create a multitude of lessons, and often the greatest teaching moments arrive unplanned and unbidden. Consider them a gift. Breathe and trust. It’s not that we said the perfect thing in a grand moment that changed our child’s life. We just need to open our hearts and try. Parenting-and spirituality- is not a scorecard. Think of it as a tidal wave of love that we are learning to surf. What works is when day after day we show up ready to try—spiritually, emotionally, and physically present—to feel and move with an open heart.”

Use Spiritual Language Daily

“Using spiritual language in daily settings is a way to point out to our children when their everyday acts and interactions reflect a spiritual quality.”

A few examples...

- "You decided for yourself whether or not to take the ice cream from the school fridge, even when other kids said it was okay. You listened to your inner compass! (or you followed your heart and knew what was right)"
- “John’s mother told me that every child in the class made fun of him when his nose was running—everyone but you. Your natural compassion made all the difference to John. He came home and told his mom about it.”
- “I saw you pick up that little ant on a tissue and take him to the backyard. Your love and respect for the spirit of every living being is so beautiful. Look how you care for sacred life. You inspire me!”

“We can purposefully ‘catch them being compassionate’ (or loving, generous or thoughtful) so they can see themselves that way.”

“Spirituality- an inner sense of living relationship to a higher power (God) that is loving and guiding.”

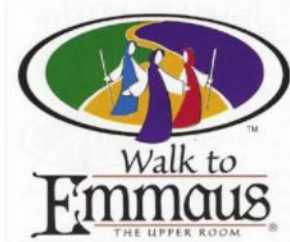

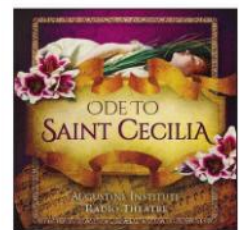

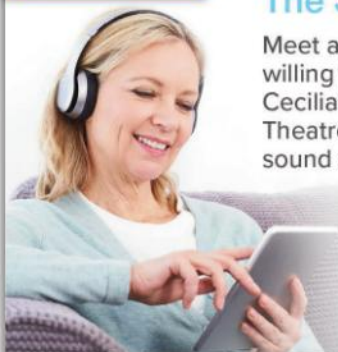
