



St. Jerome Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: THE SPIRITUAL CHILD by Lisa Miller, Ph. D.

Opportunities for Spiritual Parenting

“In our busy world, we can be so quick to express our impatience, disappointment or unhappiness to our children. Each of these moments **invite** us to be **transparent**, to show how we call on our spirituality to work through challenges. Let your child **see** and **hear** how you use spiritual experience as the path through which you **resolve** daily problems, hold relationships, and understand life events and circumstances. Show your child that spirituality can be a **resource** and how it can be supporting.”

Share: Transparency and the Voice of Spiritual Experience

This may be uncomfortable at first, but practice will give you confidence! Remember, there is no one path, but many ‘right ways’; have faith and trust God as your guide.

Situations that may arise...

- “It made me sad when Sharon behaved the way she did, but I sat and reflected on the situation and what felt deep down like the right thing to do, and realized I could forgive her in my heart and let it go.”
- “The slow service at that restaurant was so frustrating! I was going to leave a bad tip just to make the point, but then I realized--- the waiters were overwhelmed, and I could either leave a bad tip and add to their bad day, or show a bit of compassion.”
- (After a joyful event or a challenging event) “Sometimes I pray just to thank God for all the blessings in my life, and sometimes I pray because I could use some help. I personally don’t think of God as a fixer, but I do pray for the courage and wisdom to find the answers.”

Another part to being transparent is being human. Humans make mistakes. Parents make mistakes. An opportunity for spiritual parenting can come in the form of an apology.

- “I’m sorry that on this beautiful day I was so snappy and jumpy. You were kind and good, and I feel that I wasted the day for us together. So I made a little prayers asking for forgiveness for squandering the day, and I hope that you went on to have a happy rest of the day without grumpy mommy.

“Transparency is an intentional willingness to show our children how we resolve daily frustration, painful events, ethical problems and difficult decisions through our own spiritual relationship.”

“Spirituality- an inner sense of living relationship to a higher power (God) that is loving and guiding.”




