



I was hesitant, but I realized that being afraid was only keeping me paralyzed instead of giving me any answers. And the only one who could give me answers was the One who created my heart. He showed me how much joy and peace He wanted to fill in my life. Ultimately, He showed me religious life with the Sisters of Life would be filled with an everlasting joy by mothering all of the people God places with me on my earthly pilgrimage.

The Sisters of Life were founded in 1991 by John Cardinal O'Connor in New York. Their mission is to promote the sanctity and dignity of every human life. They do this through several apostolates including pregnancy counseling, post-abortion healing, and walking with people to help them see their true worth given as a gift from Love Himself. 

St. Jerome Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: THE SPIRITUAL CHILD by Lisa Miller, Ph. D.

Opportunities for Spiritual Parenting

“Spirituality is a way of living. Meeting kids where they are means you hear about mean gossipy girls at school, it means hearing about real disappointment of being cut from the team and have a spiritual perspective on it. The things that are so real and feel so big to them are not separate from spirituality. Meeting your child where he is also means a willingness to tolerate doubt and questioning about spirituality. Meeting your child also includes being present with love and interest to hear spiritual questions or hear about experiences that are unfamiliar or unsettling. When you don’t know the answer, appreciate the moment.”

Connect: Meet Them Where They Are

Sometimes our children will ask tough or painful questions, questions we may not have answers to immediately or ever. “But children aren’t asking for answers, really; they are working.” Give your child time to think about the question on his own before speaking. Children need wait time—time to process language and their own knowledge. “The ideal takeaway is to help the child learn to engage life on spiritual terms, to lean into a spiritual understanding of the world. We need only encourage the conversation, the openness and exploration of the idea, and be willing to listen with the same openness and curiosity that accompanies the question.”

Encourage the Conversation...

- “When I was a child I wondered that, too. I am so happy you are sharing these thoughts with me.”
- “You are so right that the things we do really matter.”
- “Wow, that is a moving and wonderful experience.”
- “Such joy and love! Please, will you tell me more?”
- “That sounds very important and I am so grateful you shared it with me.”

“Spirituality- an inner sense of living relationship to a higher power (God) that is loving and guiding.”




