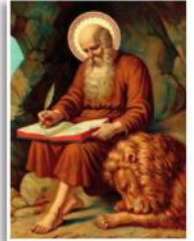

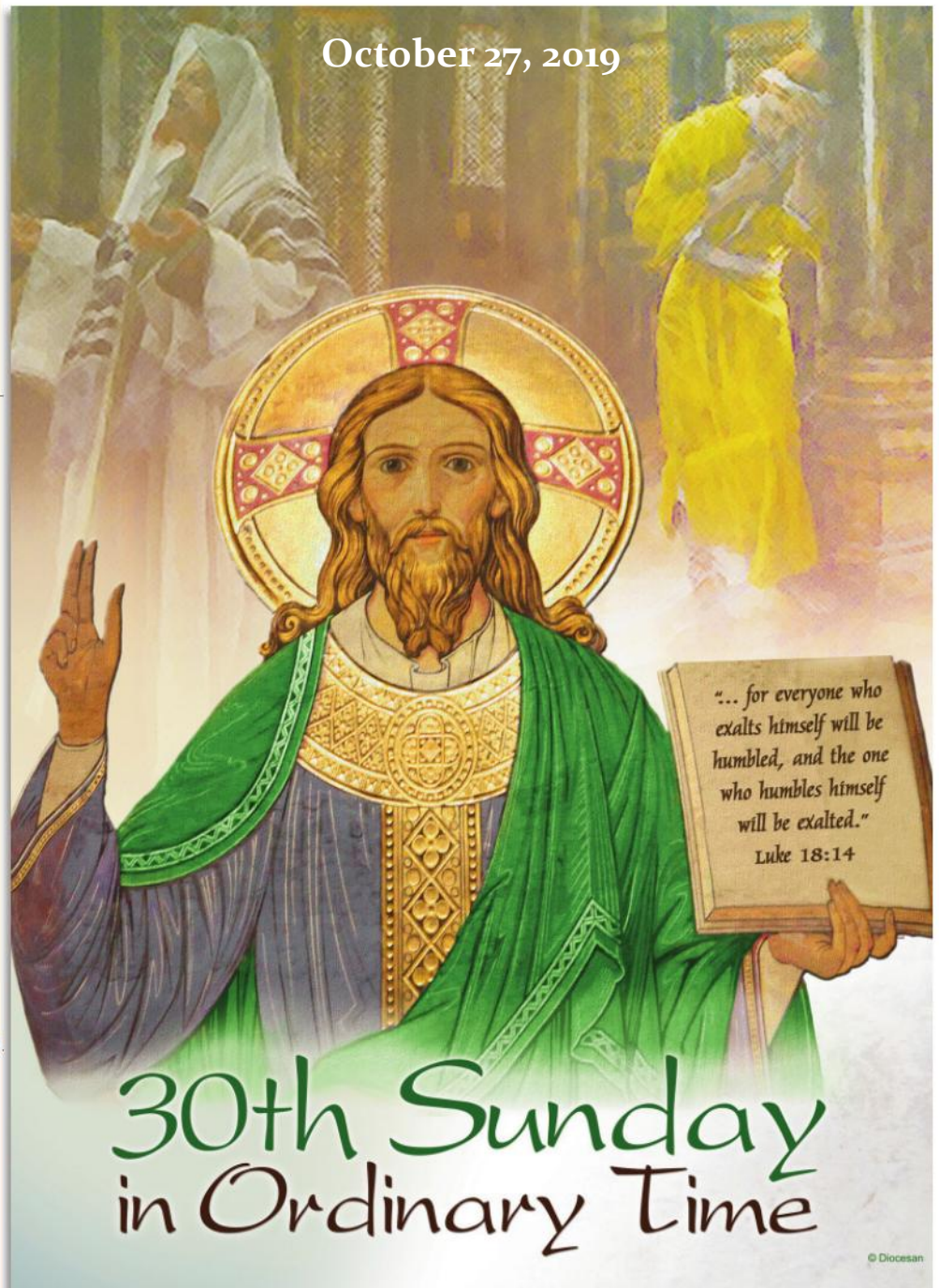

Dear Friends,

By the power of the Holy Spirit we are beginning a new ministry that will deepen and expand the person-to-person caregiving capacity of our parish. It is called Stephen Ministry.



Stephen Ministry is a way for members of our parish to train and mobilize other members to provide Christ-centered care and support to people experiencing many different kinds of life’s difficulties, including grief from loss of a loved one, divorce, terminal or chronic illnesses, unemployment, spiritual crisis and other challenges.

We have sent a team of people to be trained as Stephen Leaders, and they have returned home with the knowledge and tools to train members of our parish to be lay caregivers, Stephen Ministers. Once the caregiver training is complete, the Stephen Ministers will be available to provide care and comfort to those in need.

Here are some steps you can take as we begin this journey together:

1. Give thanks to God for the life-transforming ministry ahead of us.
2. Watch a couple of 3 minute videos at www.stephenministries.org/stories to learn more about the difference this caring ministry makes in people’s lives. You can also check the St. Jerome website for a link to these videos.
3. Thank God and pray for those in our parish whom the Holy Spirit has moved to become our first Stephen Leaders: Lissy Estrada, Cheryl Cullinan and Tim Kunish.
4. Pray for the Holy Spirit to raise up men and women in our parish to become our first Stephen Ministers. Prayerfully consider whether God might be calling **You** to this ministry.

In the weeks ahead, you will be hearing much more about the Stephen Ministry from me and members of our parish. If you have any questions about the Stephen Ministry, what Stephen Ministers do, or how you could be involved, please contact me or Tim Kunish at the parish office.

As we begin this ministry we believe that God will be at work through it. May St. John’s words inspire us to act on behalf of our brothers and sisters who are hurting: “Little children, let us not love in word or with speech, but in deed and in truth”. (1 John, 3-18)
