


Dear Friends:

We celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - Corpus Christi. We affirm as the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches:

*"The Church" is the People that God....She exists in local communities and is made real as a liturgical, above all a Eucharistic, assembly. She draws her life from the word and the Body of Christ and so herself becomes Christ's Body." CCC #752*

*"The sacraments of Christian initiation - Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist - lay the foundations of every Christian life. CCC #1212*

*"The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch." CCC #1324*

*"All gather together. Christians come together in one place for the Eucharistic assembly. At its head is Christ himself, the principal agent of the Eucharist. He is high priest of the New Covenant; it is he himself who presides invisibly over every Eucharistic celebration...." CCC #1348*

What we see before us is a God so humble and loving. Jesus chooses to be present and accessible to us. In response to this generous love, we in return sing from our hearts: *"Father, I adore You, Lay my life before You, How I love You Jesus, I adore You, Lay my life before You, How I love You, Spirit, I adore You, Lay my life before You, How I love You."*


