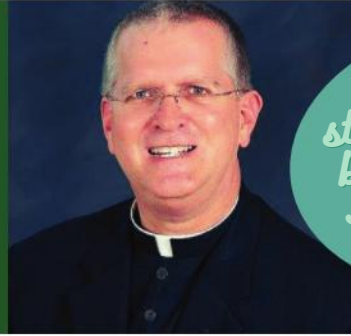

Dear Friends:

The 2022 theme for Catholic Schools Week is "Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service." Catholic schools have a specific purpose to form students to be good citizens of the world, love God and neighbor and enrich society with the leaven of the gospel and by example of faith.

As communities of faith, Catholic schools instill in students their destiny to become saints. Academic excellence is the hallmark of Catholic education intentionally directed to the growth of the whole person – mind, body and spirit. Finally, service is fundamental to Catholic education and the core of Catholic discipleship. Service is intended to help form people who are not only witnesses to Catholic social teaching, but also active participants through social learning.

Choosing a Catholic education is a decision that will last a lifetime. Not only are our students immersed in a system of education that is rooted in the teachings of Christ, but they receive a superior academic experience that develops the whole child. Our schools work diligently to ensure that the best educational practices are employed in our schools. Teachers participate in professional development opportunities to consistently expand their teaching skills to allow them to enhance their curriculum offerings.

- The student/teacher ratio in Catholic schools is 14:1. (National Center for Education Statistics, NCEA)
- 99% of Catholic students, who attend Catholic high school, graduate. Of those, 88% attend 4-year colleges. (NCEA)
- Students in our Catholic schools consistently perform above the national average at all levels on the Iowa Assessment, a nationally recognized norm-referenced standardized assessment. By the time students are in the 8th grade, they are scoring about three years above their grade level on average in English language arts, and mathematics.
- Catholic Schools save the state of Florida \$467 million and nationally more than \$20.5 billion annually.

Providing a superior quality education that is rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ is the focus of all our Catholic schools and centers. The Diocese of St. Petersburg has faith in the future of our students and our schools. There are 46 Catholic Schools and Early Childhood Centers in the Diocese of St. Petersburg. They provide a Catholic education to nearly 13,000 students in the counties of Pinellas, Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, and Citrus. All schools are accredited by the FCC (Florida Catholic Conference).

Understanding the Mass: *Final Doxology*

40. The final doxology summarizes the eucharistic prayer which concludes, as it began, on an explicit note of praise. The Church offers praise and honor to the Father through Christ who is the High Priest, with Christ who is really present in the sacrificial memorial, and in Christ who gives himself in the eucharist to the members of his body. The Church at prayer is united to the Holy Spirit who accomplishes the epiphany of Christ's sacramental and ecclesial body. The priest proclaims the eucharistic prayer in the name of the assembly which confirms and approves the action by its Amen, the Hebrew word for "So be it," given in song or a loud voice.

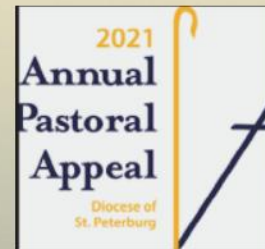

FACTS AND FIGURES FROM APA 2021

As we begin the campaign for the Diocese's Catholic Ministry Appeal 2022, we want to present information from last year's Diocesan Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA 2021) which just concluded. Last year's results are as follows:

- SJCC APA Parish Families: 1,675
- Total APA Assessment: \$ 241,535
- Total APA paid: \$ 205,429
- **Parish shortfall: \$36,106**
- Assessment paid by 2021 APA campaign: 85 %
- **Assessment to be paid by SJCC Offertory funds: 15 %**
- SJCC families participating in APA: 393
- **23 % participation**



We are *extremely* grateful to those parishioners who assisted us in raising 85% of our assessment due to the Diocese. This is a dramatic increase compared to the prior year. Thankfully, the Catholic Ministry Appeal 2022 is a goal. This means that whether we hit the goal or not, St. Jerome will not have to pay the shortfall in the future and your offertory will stay within the parish to minister within our community. We thank you for your contribution to APA 2021. We also thank you for your prayer consideration of your contribution to this year's new Catholic Ministry Appeal 2022. OUR RESPONSIBILITY: *Protecting our children*

“ Protecting our children is vital to our Catholic schools. We are entrusted with their safety, and we take that responsibility very seriously. And all I can say is “*Thank you, Jesus for our diocesan Safe Environment Program!*”

The Safe Environment staff has saved our school the expense of operating the program and countless hours of extra work, while also alleviating an enormous amount of stress for our front office and administrative staff. The centralized fingerprinting service covers the cost of fingerprinting machines (which are anywhere from \$18,000 - \$20,000). All the records for fingerprinting are stored for 5 years in the Safe Environment office, not at the school, which saves us uncounted hours in paperwork and accountability issues with the state. We save money by not having to pay the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) fee of \$6 per print to retain fingerprints on our site. Last, but by no means least, our school is saved from the anguish and stress of a surprise audit by the FDLE and/or FBI which happen every few years!

I pray we, as individual schools, NEVER have to take over this very serious responsibility. ”

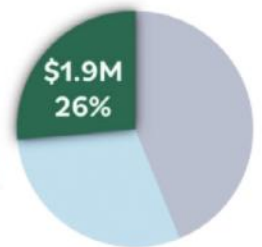

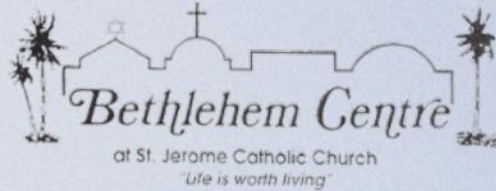

Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Mask

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.
