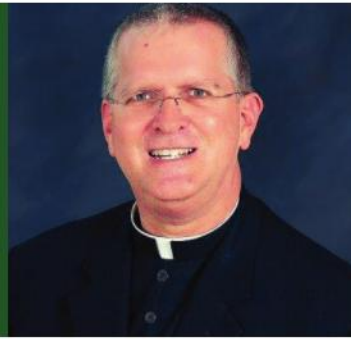

Dear Friends:

This weekend, Deacon Cris Stout will return to St. Jerome to preach the homily at all of our weekend Masses. As you may recall, Deacon Cris preached to us last year about this time, regarding our Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA). I am most grateful for your response to APA last year, as we accomplished close to 90% of our goal, the best we have ever done in any APA campaign. Understanding the Mass: *General Overview*

41. The rites of preparation for the communion are a structural link between the eucharistic prayers and the reception of the eucharist. They are to "lead directly to the communion of the people" (GI no. 56). Their purpose is to prepare the whole assembly for its participation in the Lord's body and blood. Mutual love and reconciliation are the seeds and fruits of the sacrament shared in communal fashion by ministers and people.

Being Defriended - The March for Life

"Hey Mr. Mike & Mrs. Marissa, look at my phone; I have 18 friends that just de-friended me simply because I posted about being here in Washington, D.C. at the March for Life."

That is what we heard as we were walking up the steps of the Lincoln Memorial from a teen looking at her Snapchat social media page.

This past weekend a total of 31 of us from St. Jerome's youth group, along with some of their families went to Washington, D.C. for the March for Life. We met up with St. Timothy's from Lutz with their youth group making a total of almost 50 of us!

The March for Life has been held now for the past 49 years in Washington, D.C. where peaceful protesters gather to protest the Supreme Court ruling of "Roe vs. Wade" which allowed the killing of babies in their mother's womb. Over 60 million children have been murdered since that day. This year we walked with over 100,000 other faith filled people seeking to overturn the law. The St. Jerome and St. Timothy youth groups left early Thursday morning, all meeting at the airport where we opened our bibles and prayed together while waiting for the plane to arrive. We covered a lot of ground in just 48 hours. We walked over 10 miles each day, prayed the rosary, gave witness and shared the scripture each day, and were up early and in bed late with very little sleep as we were on a mission. We even had the opportunity to meet with United States Congressman Gus Bilirakis on the steps of the Capital. One morning as we were walking to the March we were able to participate in Mass celebrated by Cardinal Wilton Gregory at the Cathedral in D.C.; then onto the March at the mall where we chanted and were simply being joyful; not to mention this was all done during blistery chilly weather!

One evening we went to see the monuments that were all lit up; from Washington to Jefferson to Martin Luther King to Lincoln and so many more! The time spent was inspiring, to see how many teens were there and being the Life generation.

On the flight home the young lady told Mrs. Marissa & Mr. Mike; "I now have over 100 people that have defriended me on social media." I answered back with; "Praise God; you are being an example of Christ in this world; be the light to shine truth." -Mike Guarino, Youth Minister

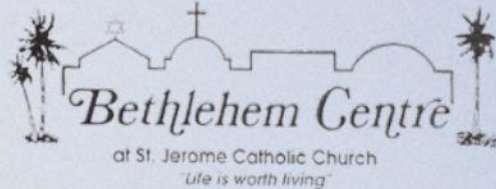

Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.
