A WAY TO PRAY

Here is a format for prayer that you may find helpful. To make it easy to remember I'll use the acronym SAVOR for the movements in this prayer and relationship. Here is how I would describe each of them:

S - Silence. As I described a couple of weeks ago, unless we find a way to turn off the noise and distractions outside our bodies and inside our hearts and minds, we'll never hear God who comes to us like to Elijah as "a small, still voice." 1Kgs 19:12 When you pray be sure to take the time you need to become quiet first, allowing yourself to become aware of the presence of God.

A - Ask for a grace. St. Ignatius of Loyola strongly recommended that whenever we pray that we be specific. "Lord, help me grow in faith," or "Help me trust you more," or "Give me the grace to love or forgive." As you begin to pray, name the grace you wish to receive.

V - Voice your thoughts and feelings. Let the Lord know what is happening in your life. What you really think and how you feel, your hopes and concerns. What in particular needs to be addressed in prayer? For what are you thankful? What worries or distresses you?

O - Openness. Many people stop praying before they hear God, but this is the time to really listen. How will God speak? Sometimes it will be through the Scriptures, spiritual reading or through something we recall another has said. Sometimes you may sense God consoling you or encouraging you. Perhaps God is calling you to something new.

R - Respond. As a result of listening in openness to God, the final movement is your response in love. Prayer changes us. It may be about the way you think or live. Or it may be a deepening of your love for God and others. I hope that these practical reflections on prayer will assist you and all of us in coming to a closer relationship with God for as much as we desire it, God desires us so much more! Next Week: "Our Catholic Treasure."



QUESTION: How can I respond to those who have hurt me, or hurt others, with mercy and forgiveness, as Jesus has shown? Whom is Jesus calling me now to forgive?

MISSION: Spend the week in active awareness of the new things God is doing in the world around you. Participate in the signs of new life you discover. Celebrate and be grateful.

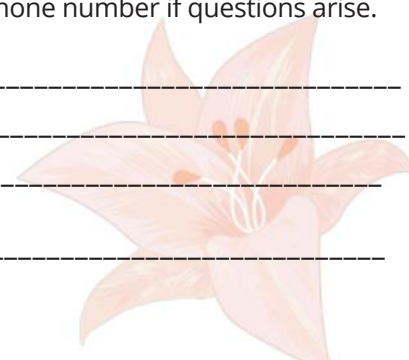

Understanding the Mass: Distribution of the Eucharist

49. As a traditional sign of service to one another a minister, saying "The body of Christ" and the "The blood of Christ," presents the Eucharistic bread and wine to the communicant. Of special significance is the invitation to receive the Lord's body since it highlights the importance of the assembled people as the body of Christ. St. Augustine explained the meaning of this phrase: "What is meant by one bread? St. Paul interpreted it briefly: 'We, being many, are one body.' This bread is the body of Christ, to which the Apostle refers when he addressed the Church: Now you are the body of Christ and his members.' That which you receive, that you yourselves are by the grace of the redemption, as you acknowledge when you respond Amen. What you witness here is the sacrament of unity" (Sermo 272). The phrase thus expresses the presence of Christ in the sacrament, the communicant, and the assembly. Each person actively responds as a mature individual and professes belief in this presence.

"The sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the eucharistic meal appears more clearly" (GI no. 240). Receiving from the cup is the sign of the new covenant (cf. Luke 22:20), the guarantee and expectation of the heavenly banquet (cf. Mark 10:38-39). Thus "it is more desirable that the faithful....should share the cup" (GI no. 56h).

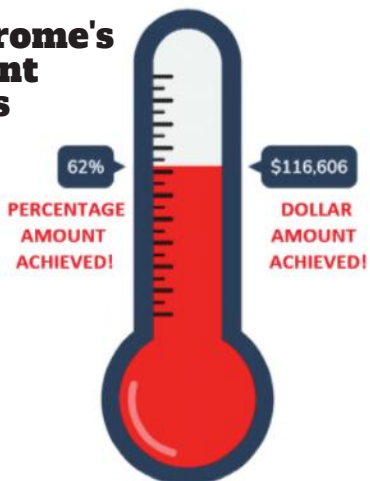

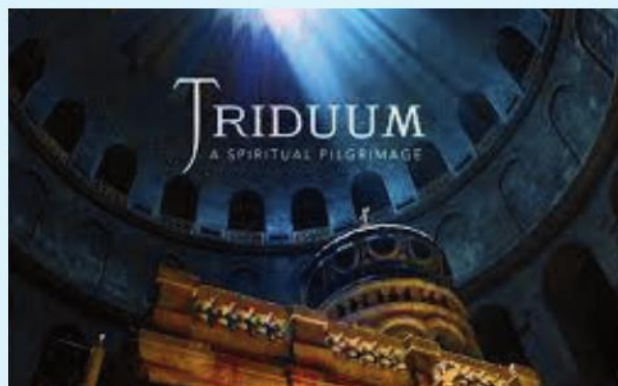

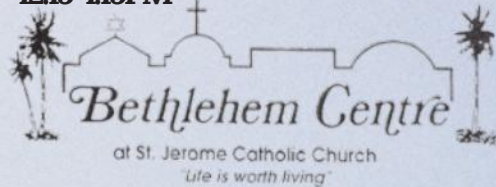

Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.
