



OUR CATHOLIC TREASURE

Last time, I explained one way to pray, but we in the Catholic Church have a rich spiritual heritage which includes so many ways to pray. The continuum stretches all the way from the silence and contemplativeness of the Carthusians to the Spirit-filled song and spontaneity of the charismatic renewal.

One thing that's been an unexpected gift to me companioning people in spiritual direction over the years has been to witness the unique ways that God connects with us. What a beautiful gift of love that God does not demand that we speak in one spiritual language, but rather God comes to us to connect to our individual personalities and our own ways of understanding so as to draw us closer in a bond of ever-deepening communion.

Of course, our central prayer as a family of faith is the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Sacrifice of the Mass. Flowing from this unimaginable gift have been many other ways of praying. Some of these we inherited from our common Jewish heritage with Jesus, and some have emerged over the centuries. Just think of the variety: the liturgy of the hours, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Lectio Divina practiced and popularized by St. Benedict and his followers, the rosary, the Stations of the Cross, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, various forms of contemplation, and a whole compendium of novenas and other devotions.



If you'd like to find out more about some of these ways of praying, I recommend *13 Powerful Ways to Pray* by Fr. Eamon Tobin, a priest of the Diocese of Orlando. Not only does Fr. Tobin describe each way, but he offers suggestions on how to begin to pray with each method. I found his book very accessible and I hope you do, too!

I hope these past four articles have been helpful to you but remember as much as you want a closer relationship with God, God desires you so much more!

QUESTION: Have I heard the reassuring voice of the Lord? While I listen for his voice, how do I witness to the difference the Risen Lord makes in my life?

MISSION: Bring new life to someone as an expression of Easter faith. Call or visit someone who is isolated. Share food and company. Be a source of joy to those who meet you. Give someone a reason to shout Alleluia!





What is the Exsultet?

The Exsultet is a stunning, triumphant song calling on the people of God to rejoice because Christ has conquered death and is alive! Also known as The Easter Proclamation, it is sung in total darkness, save the light of the Paschal Candle, near the start of the Easter Vigil.

Here are some of the beautiful lines from this lyrical prayer, along with some comments from our music director, Tom Kurt.

Tom says, "This opening section is a favorite!"

"Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven,
 exult, let Angel ministers of God exult,
**let the trumpet of salvation
 sound aloud our mighty King's triumph!
 Be glad, let earth be glad, as glory floods her,
 ablaze with light from her eternal King,**
 let all corners of the earth be glad,
 knowing an end to gloom and darkness.
 Rejoice, let Mother Church also rejoice,
 arrayed with the lightning of his glory,
 let this holy building shake with joy,
 filled with the mighty voices of the peoples.
 Therefore, dearest friends, standing in the
 awesome glory of this holy light, invoke with me,
 I ask you, the mercy of God almighty,
 that he, who has been pleased to number me,
 though unworthy, among the Levites,
 may pour into me his light unshadowed,
 that I may sing this candle's perfect praises."



Should Communion Ministers Still Wear Face Masks?

This question is asked regularly: Do Communion ministers need to wear face masks? The protocols issued by Bishop Parkes on June 15, 2020, are (for the most part) still in effect, including, it is strongly recommended for the safety of the minister and the communicant that the minister wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion. We now know the coronavirus is transmitted primarily by breathing it in via airborne aerosol particulates. We also know that breakthrough cases of Covid can occur even to those who are fully vaccinated. So for the safety of all, Communion ministers are still strongly encouraged to wear a face mask when distributing Holy Communion.
