Dear Friends,

We will bless all those who will be entering for the first time or returning to university at all our Sunday Masses this weekend. We are glad that you have joined us today in order that we can assure you of our prayers and to encourage you as you continue your education. Please stop by our "Welcome Desk" in our main gathering area of the church to complete an information sheet in order that we may send you a care package from our parish sometime in the fall. (Please complete this form even if you will be attending college locally.) Parents are asked to complete this form if your son or daughter has already left for college.

Please remember a few ideas as you take this next step:

- 1) Decide the kind of person you want to be before you go and stick to it.
- 2) Stand firm. College will test your faith. Don't believe the phrase "everyone is doing it." Because it's not true.
- 3) Make friends that have the same values as you do, even if that means not settling for the first group of friends you meet.
- 4) Get regularly involved with at least one, good Catholic organization.
- 5) Don't believe that everyone has pre-marital sex and that it's no big deal if you're a good person.
- 6) Call your parents and siblings at least once a week.
- 7) You cannot party all the time and get good grades.
- 8) Go to Mass every Sunday, no matter what.
- 9) Go to Confession once a month and look for an opportunity to go to a Catholic retreat.
- 10) Pray, read scripture, look for a good Catholic spiritual book to read, and seek a way to serve the needy. REMEMBER YOUR FAMILY AND YOUR PARISH ARE PRAYING FOR YOU.

All are invited to participate in the "Investiture of the Brown Scapular" at our 9:00am Sunday Mass on August 14, 2022. The investiture will take place after the homily. In addition, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will take place after this Mass on August 14th.

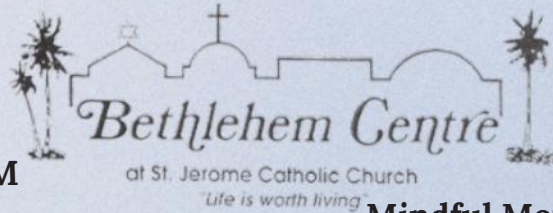
