Dear Friends,

We are truly blessed at St. Jerome to have so many wonderful youth ministry programs - St. Jerome Preschool, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Youth Ministry, etc. These ministries are possible because of the support and generosity of our community. I will be highlighting each ministry in one of my columns beginning with Youth Ministry.

After a hiatus, our Youth Ministry Program has grown substantially over the past few years. Our Middle School EDGE Ministry meets on Sundays from 3:30PM-5PM and had 41 teens in attendance this past week. Our High School Life Teen Ministry meets on Sundays from 6PM-8:15PM and had 30 teens in attendance last week. Our teens are eating together, growing in friendship, and relationship with Christ. After many years of not having a space of their own, we have found a dedicated space for them in the Education Building. They just started meeting in there a couple weeks ago and are putting it to good use. This is a testament to our parish community "buying in" to Youth Ministry.

As our Youth Ministry grows, so will the continued need for support. If you are a parent of a teen, we encourage you to help sponsor a meal on one Sunday during the calendar year. If every family steps up then all the meals will be covered. As Jesus ate with people, He encourages us to do the same with each other. 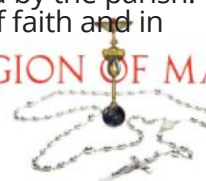


THE LEGION OF MARY
