Dear Friends,

Today we hear about our very own St. Jerome Early Childhood Center from Director Phyllis Steele. It is an incredible asset to both our parish and local community.



St. Jerome Early Childhood Center first opened its doors in 1990 in response to the needs of parishioners who were seeking a quality educational facility for preschool age children. The establishment of the area's first Catholic preschool was the vision of our Pastor Emeritus, Monsignor Muldoon. He remains an advocate and staunch supporter of its role in the community. The school is a self-supporting entity and its financial budget is balanced through tuition and fundraising efforts.

The mission of St. Jerome ECC is to provide a loving environment in which each child can achieve developmental milestones and develop skills for school success and lifelong learning. Children are encouraged to be actively involved in the learning process and to experience a variety of developmentally appropriate activities and materials. Highly trained staff provide a positive learning environment and an atmosphere where spiritual values are taught and developed. Families are welcomed into the life of the program and are involved in creating a nurturing early childhood experience for their children. Teachers provide stimulating lessons which encourage successful academic accomplishments. Through a play-based approach, they provide instruction in the eight domains of the Florida State Standards: Physical Development, Approaches to Learning, Social and Emotional Development, Language and Literacy, Mathematical Thinking, Scientific Inquiry, Social Studies and Creative Expression through the Arts.

As proof of the high-quality standards at SJ ECC, the school has continually met and maintained accreditation through the most prestigious organization in the field of early childhood. NAEYC (the National Association for the Education of Young Children) sets rigorous requirements for hundreds of program criteria. Low student/teacher ratios, a research-based curriculum, and written assessment reports are examples of the high professional standards that the staff work tirelessly to uphold. SJ ECC is also regulated by the Pinellas County Licensing Board and is a provider of the state's Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten program. Additionally, St. Jerome Early Childhood Center is a faith-based school and a proud part of the Office of Catholic Schools and Centers for the Diocese of St. Petersburg.

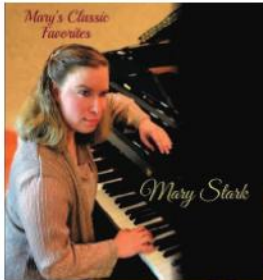

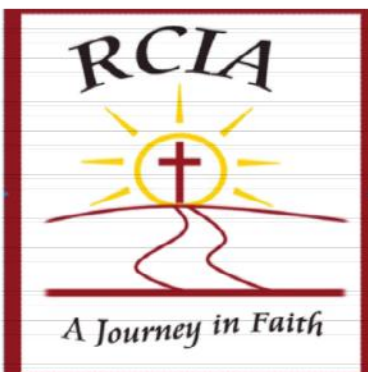

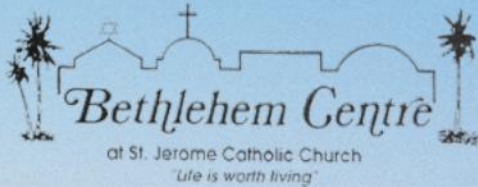
