## Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops 2022 Voter Guide

In keeping with its mission, the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB) aims to assist Catholics in active and responsible participation in political life. Each election cycle, the FCCB offers several resources to help the faithful with the obligation to make informed voting decisions. **The bishops neither support nor oppose candidates and do not intend to tell Catholics for whom or against whom to vote.** The responsibility to make political choices rests with each individual in light of a properly-formed conscience. **The following resources are approved by the bishops of Florida for use in parish or diocesan publications and for posting online.**

This year, Florida voters have the privilege and freedom to participate in voting for candidates who have come forward to serve their communities. Tuesday, November 8, 2022 is General Election Day.

The following offices will be decided:

- Federal: One of two Florida U.S. Senate seats and all 28 U.S. Representatives in Florida's Congressional Delegation.
- State: Governor of Florida, all 40 State Senators and all 120 State Representatives.

Please note that some Florida legislative candidates have been elected with no opposition. To view a list of candidates running in each race and district, visit the candidate listing on the website of the Florida Division of Elections ([bit.ly/3PgDTC0](https://bit.ly/3PgDTC0)). Click on each candidate's name to find contact information.

Before voting, Catholics are called to consider a wide range of issues important to the common good, weighing each according to its moral importance. It is beneficial to research the ballot ahead of time and gather the facts for every proposal and race. This guide offers information about Catholic teaching and questions regarding current issues to assist voters in evaluating candidate positions or political party platforms. Consider using these tools for prayer and reflection before casting your ballot.

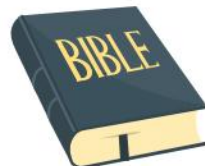

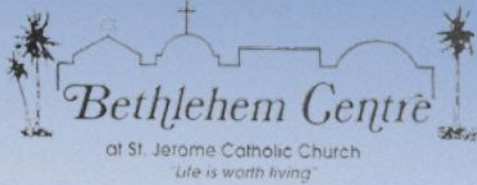
