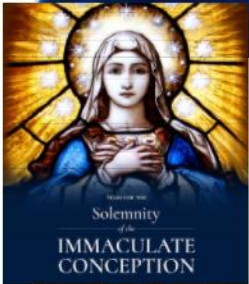
FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends:



We continue our Advent journey to Christmas, and our parish is quite lively! We will bless hay this weekend at all our Sunday Masses and invite you to take home some of the hay in the small bags provided after Mass. You can add the hay to your Nativity scene, or you can follow the custom of placing some of the hay under your tablecloth. By putting the hay under the tablecloth, we make our homes like Bethlehem, which means, “the house of bread.” Whenever we welcome guests to eat with us in love, our home becomes a place where God comes to live. Some families follow the custom of having their children place one piece of hay in Jesus’ manger every time they perform a good deed. This way Jesus will have a comfortable bed when He is born on Christmas Day.

We invite all to our Advent Penance Services with individual Confession on Monday, December 5th at 9:30AM and 7:00PM in the Church.

We are so grateful to have Chris Stefanick speak to us on Wednesday, December 7th at 7:00PM. Chris is an author, TV host, and public speaker. The topic of his talk is, “How to Live a Joyful Life”. The talk will take place in our church: the doors open at 6:00PM, the talk is at 7:00PM, followed by a question-and-answer time and book signing. Chris’ books will be available for purchase.

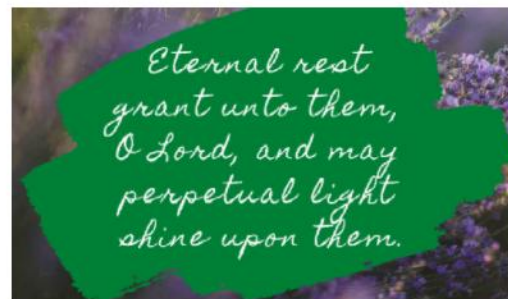

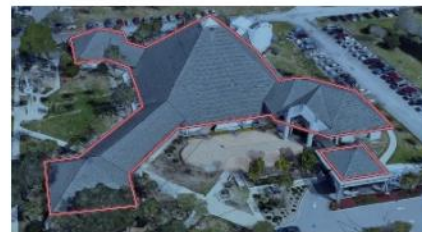

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

Metal roofs have reflective properties which can save up to 25% on energy cost for our church building. Our energy bill for the church building averages \$5,000 a month. Thus, a metal roof could cut our energy bill cost as much as \$1,250 a month which comes out to \$15,000 a year. Over the course of a 40-year warranty, the metal roof could save us as much as \$600,000. This is a very attractive benefit to replacing our shingle roof with a metal roof.

Did You Know?

Congress has permanently enacted qualified charitable distributions from your traditional IRA accounts. These distributions can be used to satisfy all or a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution. These distributions are free of federal and state income tax. Additionally, these gifts help you avoid the Medicare high income surcharge and can help to reduce taxes on your social security benefits. Distributions must be made directly from your IRA account to St. Jerome.

Maintenance Update

The exterior concrete pillars around the church had numerous areas where weathering cracked the concrete causing rebar to be exposed. To repair this issue, we hired a company for \$1,700 to fill the gaps properly with the right concrete mix so it will hold for many years.

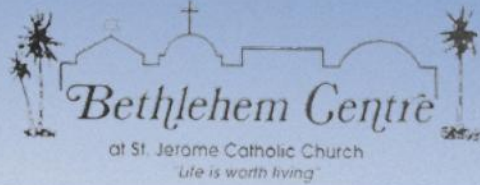

BAPTISM CLASSES And Intro to CGS

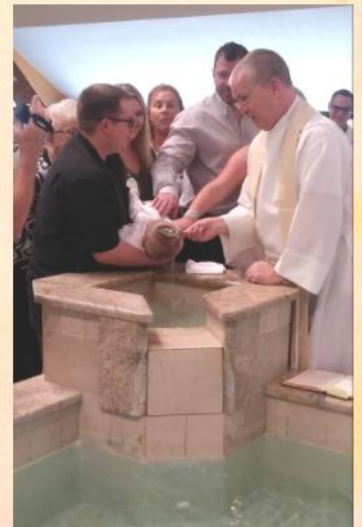
