



RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

Asphalt shingles are a petroleum product and, as such, increase dependency on fossil fuels. Plus, they require replacement every 15 to 20 years, which means that nearly 20 billion pounds of old asphalt shingles are sent to U.S. landfills every year. Metal roofs, on the other hand, are considered a more sustainable alternative for a number of reasons. For starters, they consist of at least 25 percent recycled materials and are 100 percent recyclable themselves. This is yet another good reason why we are planning on replacing our church roof with metal.

We are working hard towards the goal of \$1.4 million. Thank you for making a pledge today so we can expeditiously complete this needed project!


