

## FROM THE PASTOR - FR. TOM MORGAN

#### Dear Friends:

Pope Benedict XVI once said: "Lent is like a long 'retreat' during which we can turn back into ourselves and listen to the voice of God, in order to defeat the temptations of the Evil One. It is a period of spiritual 'combat' which we must experience alongside Jesus, not with pride and presumption, but using the arms of faith: prayer, listening to the word of God and penance. In this way we will be able to celebrate Easter in truth, ready to renew the promises of our Baptism."

We begin our Lenten Journey on Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023. We make this journey with Jesus as He accompanies us into the desert. We focus on three areas for our ongoing journey: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

#### Please remember to:

- 1. Create a Lenten plan as an individual, a married couple, and as a family.
- 2. Attend Mass on Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023. Mass schedule: 7:00AM, 9:00AM, 10:45AM, 12:30PM, 4:00PM, and 7:00PM.
- 3. Observe the Lenten Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent and Good Friday.
- 4. Attend the Stations of the Cross scheduled at St. Jerome on the Fridays of Lent in the church at 9:30AM or 7:00PM or participate in our "Neighborhood Stations of the Cross."
- 5. Participate in the Rice Bowl program for Lent and or decide on way to assist those in need.
- 6. Pick up a Lenten nail to carry with you throughout Lent as a reminder of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross and as a reminder of the sacrifices we have chosen to make in imitation of Jesus during Lent. Bring the nail with you to one of our two Good Friday liturgies and place it in the containers near the Cross during veneration.
- 7. Attend our Lenten Mission with Fr. Joe Waters scheduled for Monday-Wednesday, March 6 8, 2023 at 7:00PM each night in the Church.
- 8. Attend our Lenten Penance Service with Individual Confessions on Monday March 13, 2023, at 9:30AM or 7:00PM.
- 9. Attend our special liturgies during Holy Week. (schedule to be published soon)

May God bless you on your Lenten journey.

## Fast & Abstinence During Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Christian tradition can name at least seven reasons for fasting:

- 1. From the beginning, God commanded some fasting, and sin entered into the world because Adam and Eve broke the fast.
- 2. For the Christian, fasting is ultimately about fasting from sin.
- 3. Fasting reveals our dependence on God and not the resources of this world.
- 4. Fasting is an ancient way of preparing for the Eucharist—the truest of foods.
- 5. Fasting is preparation for baptism (and all the sacraments)—for the reception of grace.
- 6. Fasting is a means of saving resources to give to the poor.
- 7. Fasting is a means of self-discipline, chastity, and the restraining of the appetites.

# RAISE THE ROOF A solid, lasting future

#### RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

The proposed roof for the church building will be a standing seam metal roof that will provide a useful life in excess of forty years. One of the biggest benefits of standing seam roofing is the hidden fastener system it uses. The hidden (or concealed fasteners), refers to the clips, screws or nails being hidden from view on the installed standing seam roof. A key benefit of hidden fasteners is that the fastener is not puncturing the standing seam metal panel, nor is it exposed to weather which could cause them to fail over time. This usually means the standing seam metal roof has a higher level of protection from the elements, it will require less maintenance and it will provide a more attractive and appealing look for the standing seam roof.






